- Everyone was introduced
- PIO Update
 - o Main St project complete lane closure at 16th no date available now
 - o NE 8th Ave being re-paved, totally closed starting up at the 14th for about a week
 - o Off roadway events are going smoothly
 - o Phase 3 Depot Ave end to start up in January
 - o Phase 2 east side of Main St should go quicker than the west side
 - o 13th St should be finished this week after the pedestrian walkway slowed things down
 - o SR26 overpass pilings are up
 - o Dec.24th Jan3rd projects shut down except SR26
 - o University Ave open house tomorrow at Library- flyer passed out N/S Drive to Hawthorne Rd
- Paul Clark arrived with Central Office update
 - o He is over incident management and commercial vehicles

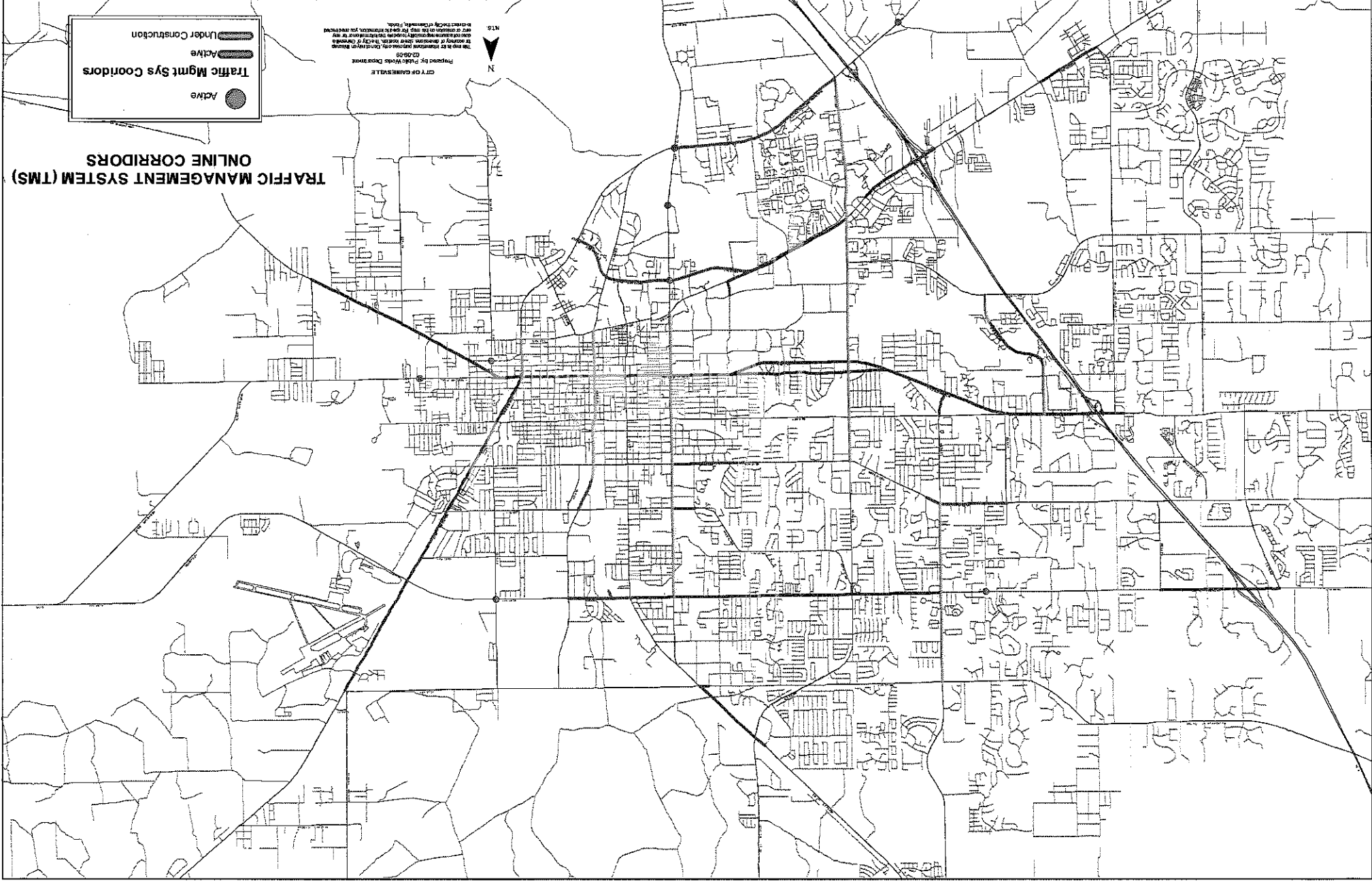
