Alachua TIM Team Meeting Wednesday, October 13, 2010

Meeting Minutes

For the list of attendees, please see the attached sign in sheet.

- Donna Danson opened the meeting by welcoming everyone and asking everyone to introduce themselves.
- Donna then stated the purpose of the meeting, which is to come together as a group to enhance communications and discuss our successes and areas of improvement for Traffic Incident Management.
- Donna stated that she had not received any corrections for the last set of Meeting Minutes so they are approved.
- Laurie Windham provided updates for Construction Projects in the area.
 - Main Street Project Next Monday the Contractor will be extending the project limits to just south of South 2nd Ave. Most businesses have been very cooperative and are not being impacted significantly. The contract is currently about 3-4 weeks behind schedule and the Contractor is currently looking at completing the work in the April or May timeframe.
 - 23rd Ave Resurfacing Project Work schedule has been shifted around to end work by 11pm, this was done due to several complaints of area residents.
 - US 301/SR 26 Overpass Hoping to have traffic on the new bridge by mid-November.
 - Archer Road Project November 1st start date for I-75 ramp/interchange improvements at Archer Road.
- Ed Ward was not able to be at the meeting, but Donna reported there was nothing significant to report with the EOC other than Hurricane Paula, which is south of Florida and is not expected to impact District 2.
- Chris Dolan introduced Mat Weisman as the City of Gainesville ITS Engineer and let Mat give the Gainesville ITS Update. (Mat provided a City of Gainesville fiber map, which is attached to these minutes for reference.)
 - Completed several wireless installations on the UF Campus for signal coordination for the football games.
 - Another wireless installation has been completed on 53rd Ave.
 - Fiber Optic Cable installation on Archer Road was completed in front of Shands. There are two wireless installations still to be completed along Archer Road, one of which is currently in design.
 - The Traffic Management Center (TMC) building has been completed. The monitors for the video wall were delivered, but the bases are on back order. This has delayed the opening of the TMC by approximately two more weeks.

- The incidents shown on a list provided by Ed Ward were reviewed and discussed by the team members
 - Bruce Strickland stated it is his understanding that Gainesville Maintenance had been notified by Gina Busscher, not FHP, of the last two serious incidents. Captain Fincher stated he was told FDOT was notified and in route with signs and cones. Bruce went to check with the front desk and the person who is most aware of the notifications is in another meeting. Bruce will have the appropriate person contact Captain Fincher directly.
 - Mat stated the City of Gainesville had tried to assist by moving vehicles through the arterial roadways when I-75 was shut down for the multi-vehicle accident on September 27th. Mat stated if the City had been notified they may have been able to provide dynamic signal coordination to assist. Mat stated the Gainesville Police Department informs them of major incidents but if they could get better information and be more involved they could assist when needed.
- Pete Vega could not attend, but wanted Donna and Craig Carnes to pass along the following:
 - The Statewide Approved Products List contract is now available for all municipalities and State Agencies. The contract and pricing can be found at the following web address: <u>http://www3.dot.state.fl.us/trafficcontrolproducts/searchResults.aspx</u>.
 - CCTV cameras, vehicle detectors, Dynamic Message Signs, traffic signal equipment and other safety items are available on the contract from manufacturers and vendors at discounted rates.
 - The TMC is now using Inrix data to track traffic conditions on I-75 in the Gainesville area. The Inrix data is generated through GPS information from commercial vehicles. The TMC Operator watches the map and when a section of roadway turns red, they are alerted to investigate. Once a traffic problem is determined, the Operator then puts the information on the 511 voice and internet systems.
 - No new ITS funding is currently in place, but there has been significant talk about ITS funding in Washington DC this past summer.
- Donna gave the general announcements:
 - The next TIM Team Meeting is currently scheduled for December 8, 2010.
 - An e-mail has been circulating warning people to be aware of plastic bottles lying around. People have been putting Drano, tin foil and a little bit of water into plastic bottles and leaving them on peoples yards or in public areas. When the person picks the bottle up to throw it away, the disturbance causes a chemical reaction, which results in an explosion within about 30 seconds. Please be cautious when picking up any bottles that have been discarded.
- Donna stated if there was no further business the meeting was adjourned.
- RISC Debrief Meeting followed immediately.


