## Alachua TIM Team Meeting Wednesday February 8, 2012

Meeting Minutes


- Donna Danson opened the meeting by welcoming everyone and asking everyone to introduce themselves.
- Donna then stated the purpose of the meeting, which is to come together as a group to help each other grow and ensure that lines of communications are kept open.
- Donna stated she had not received any corrections for the December 2011 meeting minutes, so they are approved. She had a copy with her if anyone wanted to review them.
- Donna then asked everyone to observe a moment of silence for all involved in the accidents and responders to the accidents on I-75 in Payne's Prairie.
- Ed Ward was not present to give the EOC update, but had told Donna not much has been happening besides the various wild fires around the area.
- Matt Weisman provided the update for the City of Gainesville Traffic Department.
- Most of the urban area in and around Gainesville has the traffic signals connected to the Traffic Network. Approximately 195 of the 229 signals in Gainesville are connected to the Network.
- Personnel are currently working with other agencies to get connection to the signals in the areas around Santa Fe Community College and parts of Williston Road.
- Matt is trying to get a connection to the City of Alachua and City of High Springs signals by mounting wireless antennas to cellular towers to gain line of sight to the signal locations.
- Matt and Pete have been working on a plan to install CCTV cameras along I-75 from Payne's Prairie going North toward Alachua. These CCTVs would communicate via wireless antennas back to the Gainesville TMC.
- Pete Vega provided the ITS update.
- The Statewide 511 Operations Contract is being negotiated and should be finalized soon. The winning vendor will be providing the Statewide 511 telephone and web services free of charge to FDOT. The vendors revenue will be generated through advertising on the 511 system and also roadway signage along major corridors.
- Web EOC is a coordination software that is for daily use but does especially well during multiagency responses. JSO recently had this installed and FHP is doing it Statewide. The software and installation costs are being funded through a recent grant.
- Pete/Matt/Phil have been working on CCTV coverage from South of Payne's Prairie to Alachua exit. With the exposure surrounding the I-75 accident FDOT Central Office has expressed interest in funding 2 Dynamic Message Signs, vehicle detectors and weather/fog sensors from the Micanopy Exit to Williston Rd. At this point it is unknown what mechanism will be used to Design/Construct this.
- Laurie Windham provided the Construction update.
- SR 235 Structural Course is down and daytime lane closures will continue for the next several weeks while they continue with construction and get the friction course laid.
- SR 24 West of I-75 will begin paving next week - no daytime lane closures.
- Newberry Rd. far right lane EB will be closed Sunday 8pm through sometime on Tuesday.
- Incident Debrief
- Metric Engineering presented a I-75 accident timeline presentation. The timeline shown was generated using FHP CAD reports. Captain Fincher noted the timestamps on the CAD reports were not consistent with the actual timeframes of the events due to the workload that was on the Dispatchers during the event. Captain Fincher stated FHP is in the process of getting actual timeline from putting together the radio transmissions and dashcam videos.
- During an open discussion following the presentation the various agencies present discussed the accidents from their viewpoint and how coordination occurred throughout the accident.
- Chris Gilbert stated there were no Environmental Protection Agencies informed until around 9am even though there was a Hazmat vehicle involved and fuel discharge.
- Bruce Strickland brought up his desire to have some type of Unified Command procedure and training due to several issues over the past several months where multiple agencies were involved and conflicting directions were given. Pete mentioned that FDOT District 4 has the Severe Incident Response Unit and this type of unit may be beneficial.
- Don Mozick with FDEP invited everyone to a Contractor's briefing at the Jacksonville DEP Office on Wednesday, March 7, 2012 from 1:00pm to 3:00pm. More information will be sent out in an email by Donna Danson.
- Donna personally thanked everyone for their involvement in the TIM Team and specifically the Team's efforts with the I-75 accident.
