
RISC Debrief Meeting August 8, 2012 Incident on July 28, 2012

 Donna and Ryan stated the TMC Operator that was working did not call University Towing to inform them of the RISC Activation because she had already logged that University Towing was on-scene as the rotational wrecker. University Towing should have been notified on the RISC activation. This issue has been discussed with all personnel and will not happen again. 				
University Towing O A cable failed on the rotator truck which caused it to overturn, which necessitated a new truck brought to the scene.				
Alachua Sheriff's Office O ASO was not aware of any issues.				
FDOT Maintenance o FDOT Maintenance was not aware of any issues.				
Fire Department o The Fire Department was not present.
