## Wednesday, June 12, 2013

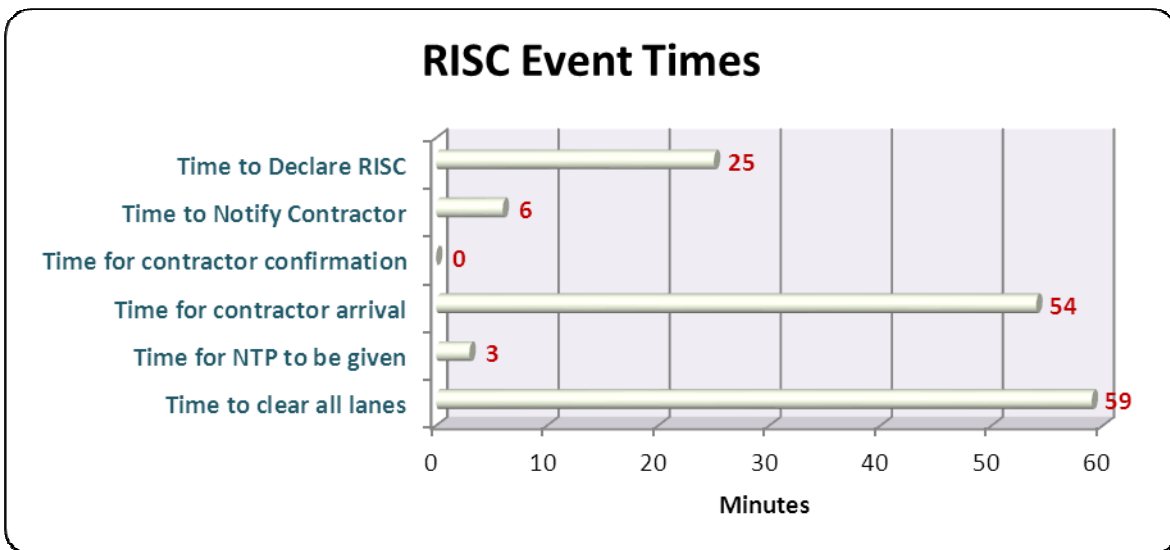
### Meeting Minutes

**Purpose:** Review the RISC incident to determine successes and areas of improvement for all responders and the TIM Team as a whole.

**Date/Time:** Tuesday, February 26 at 3:17 AM

**Location:** I-75 NB at Mile Marker 413 in Columbia County

**Preliminary report:** Crash that closed all northbound lanes with traffic being diverted off I-75 at Mile Marker 399.



- Crash occurred 3:17 AM
- All lanes blocked 3:19 AM
- RISC activation declared by FHP Sergeant Causey 3:42 AM
- University Towing notified and confirmed 3:48 AM
- University Towing arrived on scene 4:42 AM
- FHP gave Notice to Proceed 4:45 AM.
- University Towing departed; all travel lanes cleared 5:44 AM

The list of meeting attendees, the Meeting Agenda and the RISC Incident timeline are attached to these meeting minutes.

- This meeting is to discuss the RISC event that occurred on February 26th on I-75 northbound at mile marker 413 in Columbia County at 3:17 am. The crash involved two semis with a diesel spill and closed all northbound lanes with traffic being diverted off of I-75 at mile marker 399. The required clearance times were met, so the vendor qualifies for the bonus for this RISC event.
- A brief overview of the event was presented to the team showing who responded to the incident and a general timeline.
- Agencies responding to the incident were asked to provide comments.
  - FHP
    - This agency had no comments on the event.
  - Alachua County Sheriff's Office
    - Not present, but did not respond to the incident because it was out of their jurisdiction.
  - TMC Report
    - The RISC Contractor failed to contact the TMC when all lanes were open. Please remember to make all of the necessary calls as this is how the times are documented for the contract.
  - FDOT Gainesville Maintenance
    - DOT Maintenance never received a follow up call to cancel the detour (traffic was supposed to be detoured in Alachua). Not sure where communication broke down.
  - Alachua County Fire Rescue
    - The agency had no comments regarding this RISC event, because it was not within their jurisdiction.
  - HAZMAT
    - DEP was not notified of a spill. Team members did not know the amount of fluid spilled, but it did not appear to be a reportable quantity.
  - University Towing
    - No issues with the incident and no comments.
  - Open Discussion
    - There were no comments due to the fact that most of the Team Members were not present due to the incident being in Columbia County.
