First Coast TIM Meeting Tuesday September 17, 2013

Meeting Minutes





The list of meeting attendees and the Meeting Agenda are attached to these meeting minutes.

- Donna Danson welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- Attendees introduced themselves to the group.
- Donna stated the purpose of this meeting is to debrief recent incidents to work together to find out how to assist each other and make things better.
- There were no comments on the July 16, 2013 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes so they are approved as read.
- An update on the Overland Bridge Project was given by Bill Kays of KCCS.
 - The contractor is currently working in the Downtown area on Prudential Drive installing a JEA sewer line. They are keeping the area an active work zone, so they do have equipment being stored along the roadway.
 - Atlantic and Phillips Highway ramps are going to be reconfigured beginning the first week of October.
 - The contractor is constructing a collector/diverter road near the Channel 4 building and once this road is completed, the northbound traffic on I-95 will be shifted to the new roadway.
- Mike Goldman could not attend, so Donna gave the Construction Project update.
 - The Collins Road/I-295 NB ramps have been opened and by next week all of the lanes are to be opened.
 - If there are any questions regarding Construction Projects, please contact Donna to rely the information to Mike Goldman.

- Ed Ward provided the EOC update.
 - There are no current Tropical Systems threatening Florida and everything has been pretty quiet.
 - The Regional Domestic Security Task Force (RDSTF) Meeting is being held at the FDLE Training Center on Davis Street on 9/18 and is open to the public.
- Craig Carnes provided the ITS Update.
 - Construction on Phase 7, on the northeast quadrant of I-295, will be completed next week. Integration and testing efforts will begin following construction completion. Devices should be available for the TMC to use in November.
 - Due to a protest, the Phase 9 project is being re-advertised late this year. The plans are being updated to the latest specifications for this project, on the southeast quadrant of I-295, to be ready for May Let.
 - The Arterial DMS (ADMS) Project has been under test and will be operational within the next few months. This project consists of small ADMS signs on the arterial roads in the area south of the Overland Bridge which will be used for diversions to guide motorists off and on the interstate.
 - The Port Project will start construction next week. This project will run fiber optic cable to connect JaxPort facilities to the FDOT fiber optic cable allowing coordination between JaxPort and FDOT. This will help track freight movement in the area and how it affects traffic by using BlueTOAD devices connected to major hubs.
 - The I-10 Interchange Project to install new CCTVs and MVDS is on target. Devices will start going up in about 3 months and hopefully be operational by next spring.
- Greg Gaylord was not present to provide the Road Ranger update. Donna asked if anyone had any questions regarding the Road Ranger Program. There were no questions.
- Donna Danson asked for Agency Reviews
 - Sergeant Gonzalez with the St. Johns County Sheriff's Department said there
 were no significant traffic issues in and around St. Augustine during last weekend's
 concerts. He stated there was a lot of pre-planning for vehicle parking away from
 the City and shuttle buses to provide transportation to the events.
- April 27th/28th Incident Debrief Report
 - Onna went over the meeting which was held at the FHP building off of SR 16 in St. Johns County regarding the incident which occurred on April 27th and lasted into the morning hours of April 28th. Due to the extended period of the closure and confusion that arose between FHP, St. Johns County Fire/Rescue, FDOT Maintenance and DEP, a task team was developed to debrief this incident and discuss what happened and ways to make sure it did not happen in the future. The team discussed the incident and each agency went over the issues they faced

during the incident response. Throughout the meeting discussions were held on capabilities and procedures for all of the agencies. The biggest issue during the incident response was an unknown liquid, which could not be absorbed by the "kitty litter" placed by St. Johns County Fire Rescue or the sand put down by FDOT Maintenance. Once DEP was able to get a contractor on site the liquid was removed fairly quickly. The result of this meeting was a better understanding of all of the agencies' duties and responsibilities as well as exchange of contact information and procedural data.

Incident Debrief.

- Ed Ward discussed the fact his length of closure times may be off due to him normally only getting the FDOT log and not the FHP incident reports. If Ed does not receive the FHP incident report he uses the FDOT log for the start time.
- Terry Carr asked why we were using inaccurate times since one of the objectives of the TIM Team was to reduce delays and without accurate information we don't know which incidents to discuss. Donna stated the TMC does have accurate information and that is what our Performance Measures go by and if there is any doubt as to accurate time frames we can use the TMC logs.
- Ed said he will provide the incident spreadsheet to Ryan Crist in advance of future meetings so Ryan can go through the incidents to verify the times so they will be more accurate.
- Diana Rivas presented the performance measures for the last few months and reviewed some recent major events.
- Craig presented the FHWA Traffic Incident Management 2013 Team Assessment scores.
 The scores as well as areas of improvement are presented as an attachment to these meeting minutes.
- Donna gave a presentation to provide an overview of the Rapid Incident Scene Clearance (RISC) Program.
- Donna announced the next First Coast TIM Team Meeting will be held November 19, 2013.
- Craig discussed the available SHRP2 Incident Responder 4 hour course. If anyone is interested in the training please contact Craig or Donna using their contact information provided on the sign in sheet attached to these minutes.
