

# First Coast TIM Meeting Tuesday, March 19, 2013

## Meeting Minutes



The list of meeting attendees and the Meeting Agenda are attached to these meeting minutes.

- Donna Danson welcomed everyone.
- Attendees introduced themselves to the group.
- Donna stated the purpose for this meeting is to discuss recent incidents and see if there is anyway we can improve and help each other do better during accident response or clearance.
- There were no comments on the January 15, 2013 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes so they stand as approved.
- Overland Bridge Project
  - The test pile program as well as temporary drainage installation will be starting soon with work mainly being done on side roads.
  - There are no traffic pattern changes anticipated on I-95 within the next several months.
  - Ryan Crist stated on February 15<sup>th</sup> DOT construction stopped having their On-Call personnel so all construction related calls should be made directly to the TMC. He provided contact cards to Team members to hand out to their organizations.
- Mike Goldman provided the Construction Project update.
  - FHP will start to enforce the 45 mph speed limit throughout the Overland Bridge Project area.
  - Work on the I-10 Project is anticipated to be completed in the next few weeks.

- Ed Ward provided the EOC Update.
  - There are a few small wildfires spread around the District but nothing extensive.
  - There will be updates to the Homeland Security Bridge Assessments starting the first week of April.
  - Bob Kosoy asked about any word on JTA's request to install surveillance cameras under the Acosta Bridge. Ed said that the last he had heard was that surveillance cameras were not allowed to be mounted on FDOT property.
  
- Pete Vega provided the ITS Update.
  - Captain Gaston has approved the Overland Bridge Project CEI, the TMC, or JSO to request a tow truck through FHP for disabled vehicles that are impeding traffic within the construction zone at the Overland Bridge project.
  - The Phase 7 Project, on the northeast quadrant of SR 9A/I-295 is nearing completion and just had the conduit and fiber installed across the Dames Point Bridge. Completion of this project is anticipated in the upcoming Summer.
  - For the Phase 8 project on the I-295 West Beltway from I-10 to the I-95 North Interchange, testing is scheduled to begin in the next few weeks and should be available for daily use in about a month. This project will complete the installation of ITS along the I-295 Western Beltway.
  - The Phase 9 project, on the I-295 East Beltway from Atlantic Blvd south to the I-95 interchange on the south end is currently awaiting a ruling on a protest. Resolution of the protest is anticipated within a month.
  - The Phillips Hwy (US 1) Project from Greenland Road north to Downtown is basically completed but has been hindered by the US 1 Roadway Resurfacing project. Once the resurfacing project from Baymeadows Road South wraps up it will be operational. It involves installation of detection devices, dynamic message signs, cameras and upgrades to the traffic cabinets. The goal of this project is to balance the traffic load between Philips Highway and I-95 during incidents and instances of heavy congestion.
  - JTA is doing a Traffic Signal Priority project on Phillips Hwy that will extend the green light to allow emergency vehicles to proceed. The equipment is in place but testing will be slowed down due to the US 1 Roadway Resurfacing project.
  - The North Florida TPO has funded an Arterial Dynamic Message Sign (ADMS) Project which includes installing ADMS on several of the major local roadways around the southern portion of Jacksonville along I-95. The first sign went up yesterday. These signs will be used to provide motorist information for I-95 and the arterial roadways as well as detour traffic when an incident requires traffic to be diverted off of I-95.
  - The JaxPort project, which will tie all port facilities and District 2 together, will start in a few months. This will allow tracking of freight movements through the city originating from the port and also data collection, which will both help in determining where to divert traffic during major incidents.

- The Airport Road project will tie in District 2 with the Jacksonville Aviation Authority (JAA) by running a fiber interconnection to the Jacksonville International Airport (JIA). The goal of this project is to manage traffic as more flights come into Jacksonville by diverting vehicles into different parking lots.
- The Department has been working with an architect on spacing requirements for a Regional Transportation Management Center (RTMC). The goal of this center is to be one multi-disciplined facility where traffic and incidents are managed smoother than in the past.
- A project on I-75 in Gainesville is currently in design to install ITS equipment including CCTV cameras from the Marion County line to north of Paynes Prairie just south of SR 24. Additional funding was provided to extend the project through the entire Gainesville area.
- The SR 23 Toll Road Project includes adding fiber optic cable on I-95 in St Johns County, which will connect District 2 to District 5. This will allow for center-to-center communication connecting the entire state with fiber optic cable with the exception of District 3.
- The department has been tasked by FHWA to track the travel times on arterial roadways and has developed Arterial Performance Measures. These will help determine the budgeting plan and could potentially provide additional funding in the District to manage traffic on arterials.
- Within the next month there will be maintenance performed on the six bridge Wind Sensors that are currently down to get them ready for hurricane season.
- There are almost 100 BlueTooths currently deployed although the City's budget has made them difficult to maintain. The Department has asked the NFTPO for additional funding to install and maintain approximately 60 more.
- Pete Vega gave the 511/TMC update.
  - The Florida 511 Application for the Android phones is in Beta testing. Anyone who would like to try it and provide feedback can contact Ryan Crist.
  - SAIC is the new vendor for 511 and would like to deliver a product by next March.
- Greg Gaylord provided the Road Ranger Update.
  - There were 2 accidents involving Road Rangers in the past few weeks. Both incidents involved the trucks being rear-ended but no one was hurt in either. One of the accidents occurred in the Overland Bridge Construction area.
  - There is a new marketing team being created for possible future sponsorships.
  - Pete shared his recent experience of breaking down on I-95 and having a Road Ranger stop to assist him. He mentioned that the Road Ranger followed all protocols and commended Greg & Marshall for their work with the group.

- Agency Reviews
  - Gary Zimmerman with Transfield mentioned there have been several instances where personnel are responding to an incident scene to set up MOT by using the shoulder but have been instructed by officers to get in the travel lane and not use the shoulder.
    - Bob Kosoy mentioned FHP has been cooperative in letting Transfield through and the main issue has been with JSO. He stated Transfield represents FDOT on the Interstate and needs to be recognized as being there to help with the incidents.
    - Pete requested a short email from Bob Kosoy explaining the situation so he can forward it to Vicky Diaz who manages JSO dispatch.
    - Pete and Donna asked that Transfield contact the TMC when they have problems getting through so that a TMC Operator can contact JSO and let them know responders are on the way.
  - There have been issues where motorists who have been in an accident are calling relatives to come to the scene which causes an overflow of parked vehicles. In some instances relatives have gotten out of their vehicles and walked around causing danger to themselves and others. Responders are asked to instruct the relatives to go to the nearest interchange and wait.
- Incident Debrief
  - There were no incidents discussed.
- Diana Rivas presented the performance measures for the last few months and reviewed some recent major events.
- Craig Carnes presented the “Time For Safety” training video 1<sup>st</sup> Module – Introduction.
- Donna Danson gave the Announcements.
  - The next First Coast TIM meeting will be held May 21, 2013.
  - Captain Gaston will give a presentation on Signal 4 Analytic Software during the next meeting.
  - The Advanced TIM Workshop with FHWA went very well and the First Coast TIM Team was named one of the leading teams in the state. The report will be sent out to the Team when it is received from FHWA in a few months.

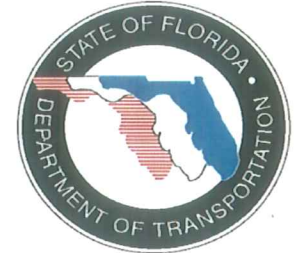

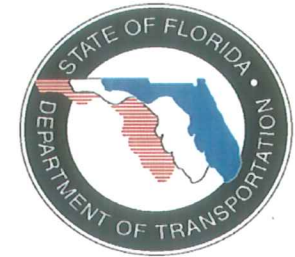

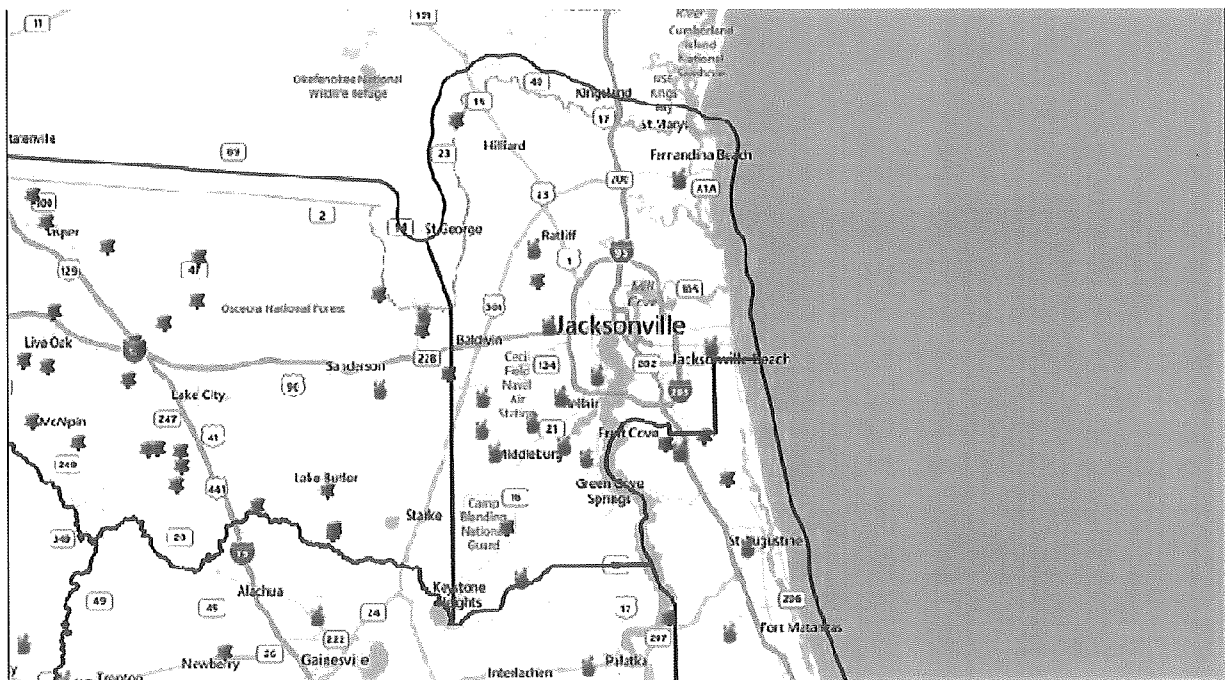

### FIRE & SMOKE ADVISORY

The Florida Highway Patrol's Jacksonville Regional Communications Center is currently monitoring several brush fires in the Nassau, Duval, Baker, St. Johns, and Clay County areas. Most of the fires are small in nature but have warranted 24 hour monitoring by state officials. The following graphic illustrates sites that have been identified by the Florida Forest Service as incident sites.

Motorists are urged to use caution when traveling in these areas. Visibility may deteriorate quickly due to smoke/fog type conditions especially during the night time and early morning hours. Motorists are reminded to reduce their speed and utilize low beam headlights in order to adapt to changing weather conditions.
