Meeting Minutes

Introductions and TIM Updates

- Josh Reichert opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Josh announced that Dee Dee Johnson has been selected as Donna Danson's replacement. Dee Dee has been involved with the Community Traffic Safety Program for years, so some of the TIM members may know her from those meetings. She was unable to attend due to a Statewide meeting in Tampa.
- Attendees introduced themselves to the group.
- The purpose of this meeting is to improve Communications, Coordination, Cooperation and Collaboration between all of our TIM agency partners.
- The April 2016 Alachua/Bradford TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously and stand as approved.

Emergency Operations Update by Ed Ward, Emergency Operations Office

- Tropical Storm Colin brought quite a bit of rain. Some tornados were reported in the Jacksonville area. The State EOC was at a level 2 and did not go to 24 hour operations. The rainfall total varied across the District but seems to have dissipated quickly due to the dry ground.
- Pete asked Ed and Steve Scanlan if there are still contracts in place to cut trees to a height above what the Asset Maintenance Contractor is required to do. Steve said there was nothing in place but they can address any issues with trees blocking CCTVs.

ITS and 511 Update by Josh Reichert, ITS/TMC Program Manager

- The Statewide 511 contract is being negotiated to revamp the entire 511 system. The brand new system should be operational and available for use by September.
- I-75/US 441 Visibility Project – The visibility sensors are being tweaked to work better. The beacon sign on US 441 is acting strange and will be checked.
- Fiber installation is ongoing on I-75 from SR 24 to Georgia. The project is ahead of schedule and should be completed by late fall. Devices will be installed under a separate contract after the fiber portion is complete.
- Pete discussed District Two Best of ITS Award nominations at ITS America which is being held next week in San Jose. The first award nomination is for the I-75 Visibility Project

which is the first of its kind in the state of Florida. The second award nomination is for the new North Florida RTMC which we believe to be the first RTMC in the country to include dispatch and operations personnel for multiple police, fire, state and local agencies.

- Pete also stated that the state is trying to get grant funding for a project on I-75 in Districts 2 and 5. This project will install ITS and use TSM&O strategies to divert vehicles off of I-75 to parallel roadways to ease congestion during road closures and large events. Even if grant funding is not awarded, the state is looking at trying to implement many of the strategies.

Construction Project Update provided by Bianca Speights, Public Information Officer

- I-75: US 441 to Sante Fe River (resurfacing) - Anticipating completion within the next two weeks weather and schedule permitting. No lane closures, but may be some shoulder closures throughout. 485 out of 496 contract days used, 98% complete, on budget.
- I-75: 39th Ave to U.S. 441(resurfacing) - Phase II work, NW 39th Ave Ramp earthwork, drainage install and pipe at SB 75 entrance ramp from 39th for guardrail. Night work milling and paving structural asphalt. Lane closures nighttime Tuesday-Thursday. Advance warning signs installed. 58 days added to 420 contract days 50% complete, on budget.
- Newberry Rd: NW 80th Blvd to SW 38th St - (resurfacing & widening entrance ramp) - Curb and turn lane repairing scheduled to be completed in two weeks weather permitting, some sidewalk closures. 40% time used, 30 days added to 300 contract days, on budget.
- I-75 Archer to GA ITS – Intelligent Transportation System installation, proofing conduit and pulling tracer wire in Alachua & Columbia MM 400 moving north. Pull boxes being installed south of US 90 Lake city Exit & north of MM 450 in Hamilton County. 262 contract days used of 498. 53% time and on budget.
- I-75: Marion Co Line to SR 121: (resurfacing) SB Rest Area Paynes Prairie resurfacing in lot completed. NB Rest Area resurfacing to be completed in the next week weather and schedule permitting. 4 days added to 344 contract days, 21% time, on budget.
- SR 121: NW 202 Place to CSX RR - (resurfacing & sidewalk work) - Lighting poles installed, driveways completed, concrete sidewalk repairs in process, joint replacement at bridge deck to be scheduled. 98 days used out of 164, 60% time, on budget.
- SR 26: University 14th to 15th Street - (signal upgrades, curb ramp reconstruction, signing and pavement markings) - Pole removal, pedestrian pole installation, concrete curb and sidewalk removal and installation. 86%of contract time used, project should be completed in 10 days weather and schedule permitting, 4 days added to contract due to weather.
- SR 226 (SW 16th Ave) from Main to Williston (resurfacing, sidewalk) – 11% time used, 60 day delay, paving operations will start in 1 week weather and schedule permitting.
- An alternative truck route around Starke will begin in the fall.
- Steve Scanlan gave an update on the Celebration Point Project.
- Ed Ward asked if the US441 at I-75 Project was complete. Steve explained that it was part of another project for resurfacing and is not complete.

- **Agency Reports facilitated by Josh Reichert**

- FHP
 - Increased patrols due to construction.
 - Lt. Caulk moved to Lake City and Lt. Young is taking his place.
- Local Police/Sheriff's Offices – Nothing to report.
- Maintenance/Asset Management
 - Jorgensen – A lot of storm preparation was done but nothing else out of the ordinary.
 - Brian Johns discussed an issue with a beaver building dams near US 301.
- Environmental/HAZMAT – Nothing to report.
- Medical Examiner

- Catherine Weldon discussed two fatalities.
- Emergency Management
 - Dave Donnelly has left Alachua County and a replacement for him is being sought.
- Towing/Wrecker – Nothing to report.
- City of Gainesville – Not in attendance.
- Forestry
 - Jamie Rittenhouse gave a report for Alachua and Bradford Counties. Since the last meeting there have been 9 wildfires in Alachua County for a total of 121.7 acres, and 2 fires in Bradford County for a total of 0.2 acres. In Alachua County, there have been 495 authorized burn piles, and 322 authorized fires for a total of 2,682 acres. In Bradford County, there were 118 authorized burn piles, and 79 authorized fires for a total of 6 acres.

Incident Debrief led by Josh Reichert

- Several incidents which lasted over 90 minutes were briefly discussed. Team members who were present at the incident scene were asked to provide input as to what went right and what could have been done better.

Closing Remarks

He will work with any agencies' schedules, including nights and weekends to make the training course available. He is able to conduct training for groups of ten or more students.
- Dave's Hi-Way Towing and Shelby's Towing and recovery are now both on the RISC contract.
- A discussion was held to determine if the Alachua/Bradford TIM Quarterly Newsletter was being received well by TIM members. It was determined that it was not being read by a majority of the group and was not needed. The group will begin receiving the ITS Newsletter via email which is sent out at the beginning of each month. This newsletter will be updated to have more information on the Alachua/Bradford area, as currently it only includes a section on the TIM Team.
- Josh asked everyone to try to think of ways that we can improve the TIM Team meetings to encourage attendance from a broader audience. Please provide any suggestions to Josh or Craig.
- Next Alachua/Bradford Traffic Incident Management Team meeting will be August 10, 2016 at the FDOT Gainesville Operations Office – 5301 N.E. 39th Ave., Gainesville, Florida.
