Introductions and TIM Updates

- Josh Reichert opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Josh announced that a RISC Debrief meeting will be held directly after the TIM meeting.
- Josh introduced Dee Dee Johnson and stated that she would be running the meeting.
- Attendees introduced themselves to the group.
- The purpose of this meeting is to improve Communications, Coordination, Cooperation and Collaboration between all of our TIM agency partners.
- The June 2016 Alachua/Bradford TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously and stand as approved.

Emergency Operations Update by Ed Ward, Emergency Operations Office

- The peak of Hurricane season is in the middle of September.
- The 2nd Annual Hurricane Newsletter will be sent out in a few days.

ITS and 511 Update by Josh Reichert, ITS/TMC Program Manager

- The new 511 system will be activated over Labor Day weekend. The phone app, voice and website will all be updated and arterial roadways will now be covered.
 - o Ryan Crist noted that the reliability will be improved.
 - Users will most likely have to re-download the new app but the old app will alert users to do so.
- A small DMS will be installed southbound on US 441, before Paynes Prairie. The project will be LET soon and work will begin in November.
- Fiber optic cable installation is ongoing on I-75 from SR 24 to Georgia. The contractor is currently installing fiber optic cable into the master communicator's hub at I-10 and I-75.
 The project is ahead of schedule and should be completed by late fall. Devices will be installed under a separate contract after the fiber portion is complete.
- AAG expressed concern regarding empty conduit locates close to MM 399. DBI to perform locates.

Construction Project Update provided by Bianca Speights, Public Information Officer

• I-75: US 441 to Sante Fe River (resurfacing) - Completed June 17th.

- I-75: 39th Ave to U.S. 441(resurfacing) Paving work on eastbound 39th Avenue ramp. Completion scheduled 2nd week of September. Includes striping, sign work and tree trimming/clearing and grubbing. Repairing asphalt due to damage from fuel spill & fire. Bridge repair near CR 241 due to dump truck incident will require single lane closure on CR 241 and double lane closure on I-75. Traffic officer requested for the first week that Santa Fe college will be back in session (Aug 22). 319 contract days used of 498 days, Time: 64% Money: 60%. Jan 2017 completion.
- Newberry Rd: NW 80th Blvd to SW 38th St (resurfacing & widening entrance ramp) Paving, sidewalk, curb and gutter work. Eastbound side of Newberry resurfacing to be completed within next two weeks, weather permitting. Exit ramps to receive new reflective signs. Lowering signal heads NB I-75 exit ramp within 30 to 60 days. Paving scheduled for completion end of September, weather permitting. 218 contract days used of 341. Time: 57% Money: 37%. Completion December 2016.
- I-75 Archer to GA ITS Intelligent Transportation Systems project is installing pull boxes and conduit south of the agricultural station heading north. Sub-contractors are installing mowing pads around the pull boxes and splice vaults at MM 400 heading north. Fiber Optic install beginning next week. 315 contract days used of 500. Time: 63% Money: 74% Completion Jan 2017.
- I-75: Marion Co Line to SR 121 (resurfacing) Paynes Prairie Rest Area resurfaced. Pothole to be repaired at northbound Rest Area. There is currently no work due to other projects nearby. 117 contract days used of 354. Time: 33% Money: 13%.
- SR 121: NW 202nd Place to CSX RR- (resurfacing, sidewalk and sign work) Project completed August 5.
- SR 226 (SW 16th Ave) from Main to Williston (resurfacing, sidewalk & lighting) Paving, widening and lighting on Main (SR 226). Time: 56% Money: 26%. Weather days to be added.
- Starke Alternative Truck Route: Start date delayed to August 10, 2016 due to weather.
 Road construction expected to begin on west side of Starke. Project expected to be completed in 3 years.

Incident Debrief led by Josh Reichert

- Several RISC incidents were briefly discussed. Team members who were present at the incident scenes were asked to provide input as to what went right and what could have been done better.
 - o 7/26/16 MM 389
 - NTP was delayed.
 - FHP addressed issues with the trooper that responded. The trooper was not aware of who to notify during such an event.
 - The area had limited shoulder width due to barrier wall, which made it difficult to push the truck off of the road to clear lanes.
 - o 8/8/16 MM 384
 - Approximately 50 gallons of fuel was leaked.
 - Shelby's Towing was on scene for approximately 1 hour before given to NTP.
 - The fuel leak caused the delay.
 - AAG asked if FHP could communicate with incident responders a little better.
 - FHP can escort responders to the scene, but are short on troopers at the moment.
- Captain Tierney suggested using the tape rumble strips leading up to construction zone similar to I-75 in Tampa.

- Ryan focused on how we can get more SHRP2 Trainers available to train, and how we can
 get more agencies involved in being trained.
