Alachua/Bradford TIM Team Meeting Wednesday February 10, 2016

Meeting Minutes





- Donna Danson opened the meeting by welcoming everyone and asking them to introduce themselves.
- Following introductions, Donna stated the purpose of the meeting is to work together as a team and learn from each other.
- Donna stated there were no comments for the previous Meeting Minutes so they are approved as read.
- Ed Ward gave the EOC Update.
 - El Nino effect is evident with the cooler temperatures.
 - Brian Johns had no update for Bradford County.
 - Emergency Management Assistance C (EMAC) FDOT sent dump trucks to D.C.
- Josh Reichert gave the ITS and 511 Update.
 - Due to recent fog issues the DMS on I-75 and US 441 have been used and have worked well.
 - Fiber installation is ongoing on I-75 from SR 24 to Georgia. The project is ahead of schedule.
 - Smaller DMS will be installed on US 441 SB in place of one that had been planned on the previous project.
 - The Statewide 511 contract is being negotiated to revamp the 511 system.
 - Steve Scanlan mentioned that Praksoft has installed fog devices within Payne's Prairie in coordination with UCF.
- Rebecca White gave the Construction Project Update.
 - I-75 Resurfacing north of US 441 to the Santa Fe River Structural course is completed on the mainline. Traffic is reduced to two lanes in each direction at the Santa Fe River Bridge for joint work. Friction placement should begin once the weather warms up. The project is scheduled for completion in the spring.

- I-75 Resurfacing south of NW 39th Ave. to north of US 441 and at NW 39th Avenue (SR 222) Work on the I-75 northbound exit ramp to Northwest 39th Avenue and paving on the mainline is ongoing. All four lanes of U.S. 441 reopened February 3. The next phase of the project will require closing the southbound on-ramp to I-75 from U.S. 441 northbound at the Exit 399 interchange along with the southbound outside lane between U.S. 441 and the old CSX railroad bridge. The continuous 12-day closures are scheduled to begin March 20. The new southbound on-ramp will remain open. Once the work on the southbound side is completed, the I-75 northbound outside lane between the old CSX Railroad Bridge and U.S. 441 and off-ramp to U.S. 441 will completely closed for around 12 days. The project is scheduled for completion in fall 2016.
- I-75 Resurfacing from the Marion County line to the Williston Road interchange (Exit 382)
 The project will begin in March and be completed in early 2017.
- Newberry Rd. (SR 26) Resurfacing west of Northwest 80th Avenue to Southwest 38th Avenue (3 miles) - Work on sidewalks is underway. Paving will begin in April. There are nighttime lane closures Monday through Saturday from 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. The project is scheduled for completion in fall 2016.
- State Road 121 Resurfacing/sidewalk Northwest 202nd Place to south of the CSX railroad crossing - Construction in LaCrosse is underway and should be completed in late spring.
- State Road 26 (East University Avenue) Signal Upgrades Signals will be upgraded from 14th to 15th Street. Construction is scheduled to begin March 29.
- State Road 226 (Southeast 16th Avenue) Intersection Improvement from Main Street to Williston Road - The project is scheduled to begin March 10 and should be completed by summer.
- Bradford County: Alternate Truck Route The first two legs are scheduled to let March 30. The limits are from State Road 100 to State Road 16 and from State Road 16 to U.S. 301. The third leg from U.S. 301 to State Road 100 is scheduled to let in May.
- Donna led the Agency Reviews.
 - o FHP-
 - A new Captain will be taking over for Captain Fincher. The team wishes Captain Fincher the best of luck.
 - > FHP is stretched fairly thin with construction, the fire season, and vacant positions.
 - City/County Police Departments
 - UF Police Department officer Bart Knowles introduced himself to the team.
 - Maintenance/Asset Management
 - DBi has agreements with the two I-75 roadway contractors.
 - Medical Examiner Not present.
 - Fire Department
 - Chief Stewart mentioned an increase in grass and forest fires likely due to low humidity, frost and high winds.
 - Emergency Management
 - Nothing to discuss.
 - Wrecker Association Nothing to discuss.
 - Division of Forestry -
 - Jamie Rittenhouse was unable to attend but sent a report for Alachua and Bradford Counties. Since the last meeting there haven't been any wildfires in Alachua or Bradford. In Alachua County, there have been 270 authorized burn piles, and 388 authorized fires for a total of 275 acres. In Bradford County, there were 85 authorized burn piles and 29 authorized fires.

- FDEP-BER / Alachua Environmental
 - > Don Mozick mentioned that fuel spills related to accidents are not being reported.
 - A 4" conduit was found that was unused and had been installed in 1993.
 - > Chris Gilbert mentioned an incident last Friday with incorrect information on the milepost of the incident.
- City of Gainesville Not present.
- Donna led the Incident Debrief.
 - Metric will start sorting the Incident List by roadway, with each roadway sorted by date.
- Randy Wilbourn with the FDOT Innovative Team provided a Detour Protocol Presentation.
 - This detour protocol idea was submitted by an employee as a concept idea on traffic affected not necessary by the incident but more-so by the re-route.
 - The team is asked to be thinking of methods of improving the detour process. Randy and the task team will be checking back in the upcoming meetings.
