Alachua/Bradford TIM Meeting Wednesday, February 8th, 2017 Meeting Minutes

The list of attendees, agenda, and meeting handouts are attached to these meeting minutes.



Introductions and TIM Updates

- Dee Dee Johnson opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- The purpose of this meeting is to improve Communications, Coordination, Cooperation and Collaboration between all TIM agency partners.
- Attendees introduced themselves to the group.
- The December 2016 Alachua/Bradford TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously and stand as approved.

Emergency Operations Update provided by Ed Ward, FDOT Emergency Operations

• Ed Ward was unable to attend the meeting due to previous commitments. Brian Johns, with Bradford County EOC, was also unable to attend due to wind damage sustained during the storms last night in Bradford County.

ITS, 511 and RTMC Update provided by Craig Carnes, TMC Consultant Project Manager

- The installation of fiber optic cable on I-75 from SR 24 to the Georgia State Line has been completed. A new project has begun to install ITS devices and power infrastructure within the same project limits and is expected to be completed by Fall 2018.
- The I-10 project which is installing fiber optic cable from US 90 in Tallahassee, FL into Jacksonville, FL has begun. Construction crews are installing conduit, fiber optic cable, and pull boxes from the west side of the project and are moving to the east. This project is expected to be completed by Fall 2018. The design for a project to install ITS devices and power infrastructure within the same project limits is well underway. This project will be Let for Construction in July 2017 and is expected to be completed in early 2019.
- The ITS Maintenance Contractor will be installing fiber optic cable and conduit along SR 222 from SR 24 to the Operations Buildings. This communications connection will allow personnel within the building to view CCTV videos over the ITS Network.
- District 2 ITS and Central Office have been discussing possible strategies for reducing incidents and incident related congestion in the Gainesville area. These strategies include:
 - o Road Ranger Service Patrols on I-75.

- A new towing contract, similar to the RISC contract, but for smaller vehicles such as box trucks. This contract would be for I-75 only.
- Use of FDOT employees with specially equipped vehicles to serve as Incident Commanders and assist with Incident Management at major incidents.
- Dynamic Speed Signs on I-75 which would dynamically change the Speed Limit as motorists' approach Gainesville. These signs would reduce the Speed Limit when there is heavy congestion or adverse weather conditions.
- The FRAME (Florida Regional Advanced Mobility Elements) Project will be under design soon. This project will include devices and infrastructure on both I-75 and arterial roadways from North of Gainesville going south into Marion County. The project will include signal modifications, ITS devices and connected vehicle technologies.
- There will soon be a Traffic Signal interface within SunGuide, which will allow TMC
 operators to dynamically change signal timings to help alleviate congestion during incidents
 and planned events. This enhancement has been in development for several years and
 was spearheaded by District 2. The new interface will be available with the new SunGuide
 update, which will be released this Spring.
- The new 511 vendor has continued to work on making improvements to all aspects of the 511 system. At this point they feel that they are making progress as there are more trouble tickets being resolved each week than are being added.

Construction Project Update provided by Bianca Speights, Public Information Office.

- Bianca Speights was unable to attend the meeting.
- Steve Scanlan provided the following information:
 - Construction is nearing completion on the resurfacing project on I-75 from NW23rd Avenue to approximately mile marker 400.
 - Construction for the resurfacing projects on I-75 from NW 23rd Avenue to the Marion County line are ongoing and is unfortunately behind schedule.
 - Newberry Rd is essentially complete with some minor striping and clean up to be done.
 - There is major construction also going on with the Starke Alternate Truck Route, currently about 15% completion has been accomplished, overall project completion date will be in 2019.

Incident Debrief – (Ed Ward's List attached)

- I-75 closure January 31st, 2017, due to visibility. The detours are very lengthy and run through rural areas, so there aren't any good alternatives.
- There was a short discussion on an incident in Clay County that involved a Construction truck working on the Starke Alternate Truck Route.
- Steve Scanlan discussed a potential controlled burn in Paynes Prairie Park. Fire breaks have already been created in the area and extensive preparation has been done to limit the potential of the fire getting out of control.

TIM SERIES: Agency Event Management

 Craig Carnes discussed the upcoming SHRP2 Incident Responder Training courses which will be held in the Operations Building auditorium. Both training sessions will be held on February 22nd, with one being held in the morning from 8am to noon and the other being held in the afternoon from 1pm to 5pm.

Agency Reviews – Open Forum

- FDOT Maintenance Sam Aggerton discussed that FDOT is doing a study on guardrail damage resulting from accidents. They ask that they be notified on any guardrail damage so that the damage can be photographed and documented.
- Florida Forest Service Jamie Rittenhouse provided a summary of the authorized burns and wildfires in both Alachua and Bradford Counties.

Closing Remarks

- Craig Carnes reiterated the details of the upcoming SHRP2 Training courses. If anyone is
 interested in setting up another SHRP2 Incident Management Training Course, please
 contact Craig Carnes at ccarnes@metriceng.com. He will work with any agencies'
 schedules, including nights and weekends to make the training course available. He can
 conduct training for groups of 10 or more students.
- The next Alachua/Bradford Traffic Incident Management Team meeting will be April 12th, 2017 at the FDOT Gainesville Operations Office 5301 N.E. 39th Ave, Gainesville, Florida.
