Meeting Minutes

Introductions and TIM Updates

- Dee Dee Johnson opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- The purpose of this meeting is to improve Communications, Coordination, Cooperation and Collaboration between all TIM agency partners.
- Attendees introduced themselves to the group.
- The April 2017 Alachua/Bradford TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously and stand as approved.

Emergency Operations Update

- Ed Ward was unable to attend the meeting, but he informed Dee Dee that there are currently no updates.
- Steve Scanlan explained that the Department is changing their evacuation plans from One-Way Evacuations to Hard Shoulder Running. This emergency evacuation plan will be called Shoulder Use for Emergency Evacuation (SUEE). The plans are to implement this on I-10 WB on the West side of US 301 to I-75. The implementation on I-75 will go from near Tampa to the Georgia state line. I-10 will utilize the outside emergency lane while I-75 will utilize the inside lane. Fold-up/fold-down signs are currently being installed for direction information.

ITS, 511 and RTMC Update provided by Craig Carnes, TMC Consultant Project Manager

- The I-75 project is moving along to install ITS devices, poles, etc. This project should be complete by Spring of 2018.
- Conduit has been installed on the I-10 project from Jacksonville to Tallahassee. This project is expected to be complete considerably early.
- In the upcoming months, there will be another construction contract LET for ITS devices on I-10.
- Pending funding, there is a plan to have Road Rangers cover all Interstates throughout the District.
- There is now a fiber connection from SR 24 up SR 222 to the middle building of the Operations Complex. There will be a connection in the conference room with a switch that

can be made available to other areas. This will provide a connection to the ITS Network and allow viewing of incident scenes, etc.

- Ryan Crist mentioned ongoing testing of a new SunGuide feature with the City of Jacksonville. SunGuide now has an interface where the TMC Operators can implement alternate timing plans for minor incidents.

Incident Debrief – (Ed Ward’s List attached)

- The Team discussed several incidents. A UPS driver was severely injured at the incident on April 28th. The incident on May 26th had a long duration due to the investigation process. Several incidents will be reviewed during the RISC Debriefs following this meeting.

Craig lead the Team in the annual TIM Self-Assessment.

Agency Reviews – Open Forum

- Florida Forest Service – Jaimie Rittenhouse stated that it has been a very active fire season, although the rain has helped some. There are currently 45 fires impacting 335 acres. Jamie thanked everyone for their assistance providing smoke signs and road closures.
- Bradford County EOC – Brian Johns announced the FEPA Mid-Year Work Session will be held August 2nd-4th in Panama City Beach.
