## August 8, 2018



### Meeting Minutes

#### **Introductions and TIM Updates provided by Dee Dee Crews, D2 ITS Operations Project Manager**

- Dee Dee Crews opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- The purpose of this meeting is to improve Communications, Coordination, Cooperation and Collaboration between all TIM agency partners, as well as to improve safety and congestion on the highways.
- Attendees introduced themselves to the group.
- The June 2018 Alachua/Bradford TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously and stand as approved.

#### **Emergency Operations Update provided by Ed Ward**

- There is very little to report at the moment.
- The main issue right now is flooding at the Santa Fe River but it doesn't pose a risk for closure.
- Steve Scanlan noted that Paynes Prairie is still high; only about 9 inches below where we were with Hurricane Irma.
- Work is being done at Camps Creek to clear log jams to improve drainage and decrease the amount of water flowing into the prairie.

#### **ITS, 511 and RTMC Update provided by Craig Carnes**

- Road Rangers and RISC Lite have been implemented in Gainesville.
- The fiber connections to Lake City are complete.
- Steve noted that the link to the Gainesville folder is no longer working. Jason Summerfield to look into this.

#### **Road Rangers Update provided by Dee Dee Crews**

- Two Road Ranger routes have been added and go up to the Georgia State Line, Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

- Steve asked if Road Ranger assistance for University of Florida football games would be beneficial. Captain Tierney noted if there was a crash then it would be beneficial. Dee Dee will check on available funding to see if this would be possible.

### **Diversions Routes Feedback provided by Craig Carnes**

- Craig noted that there has been no feedback so far regarding the Diversion Routes. He encouraged the Team to get with himself or Dee Dee if they have any comments, concerns, or advice. ### **Incident Debrief – (Ed Ward’s List attached)**

- The Team discussed the following incidents:
  - July 11<sup>th</sup> on US 301 at Walmart in Starke
    - Trevor Howes with Jorgensen noted this was a clean-up involving animal parts, fat, etc.
  - Ed mentioned two incidents that should be added to the list. They are as follows:
    - I-75 southbound at MM 396
    - I-75 northbound
    - They both had long duration times and 20-mile back-ups due to onlooking motorists. The group had a discussion regarding using screens or tarps during fatalities to avoid onlookers and motorists taking photos to put on social media. Dee Dee and Greg Gaylord noted there is some benefit cost issue which prevents agencies using the screens.
  - July 13<sup>th</sup> on SR 26 at US 301 in Hawthorne
    - The signals and incident ran smoothly. There was only an issue with getting access to the chopper.
    - It seems there was a breakdown in communication between the TMC, FHP, and FDOT.
  - July 27<sup>th</sup> on SR 121 at SR 235
    - The semi-truck was hauling fly ash, not dirt, as noted on the incident list. This is the reason it took so long to clean up.
    - Chris Gilbert mentioned that communication and misinformation have been an issue within Alachua County.

### **Road Rangers/RISC Lite Presentation**

- Craig provided the group with a presentation on Road Rangers and RISC Lite. A copy of this presentation is attached to these meeting minutes.

### **Open Forum**

- Chris Dolan mentioned an app called EnLighten that gives signal timing information.

### **Closing Remarks**

- The RISC debrief meetings will be held directly after this meeting.

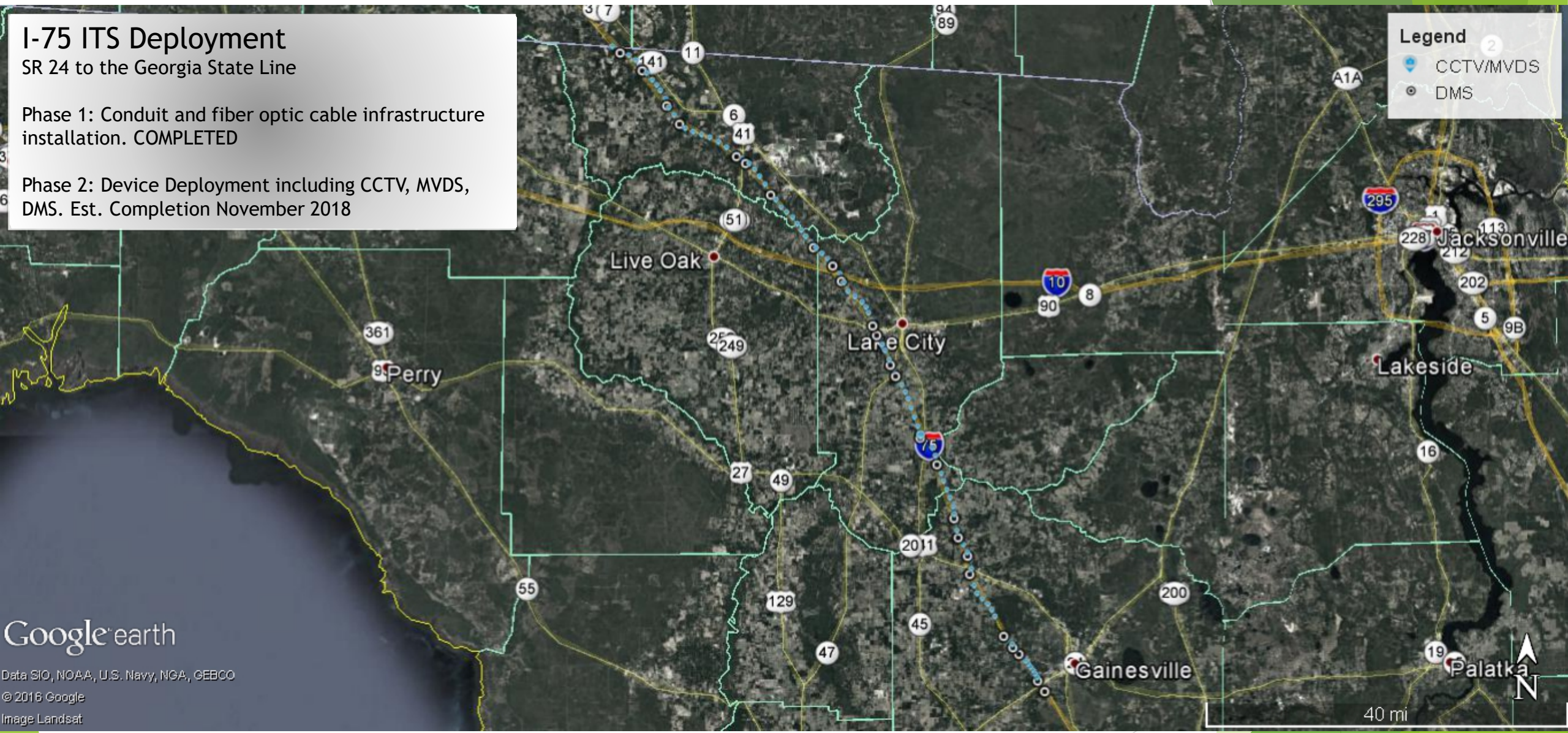

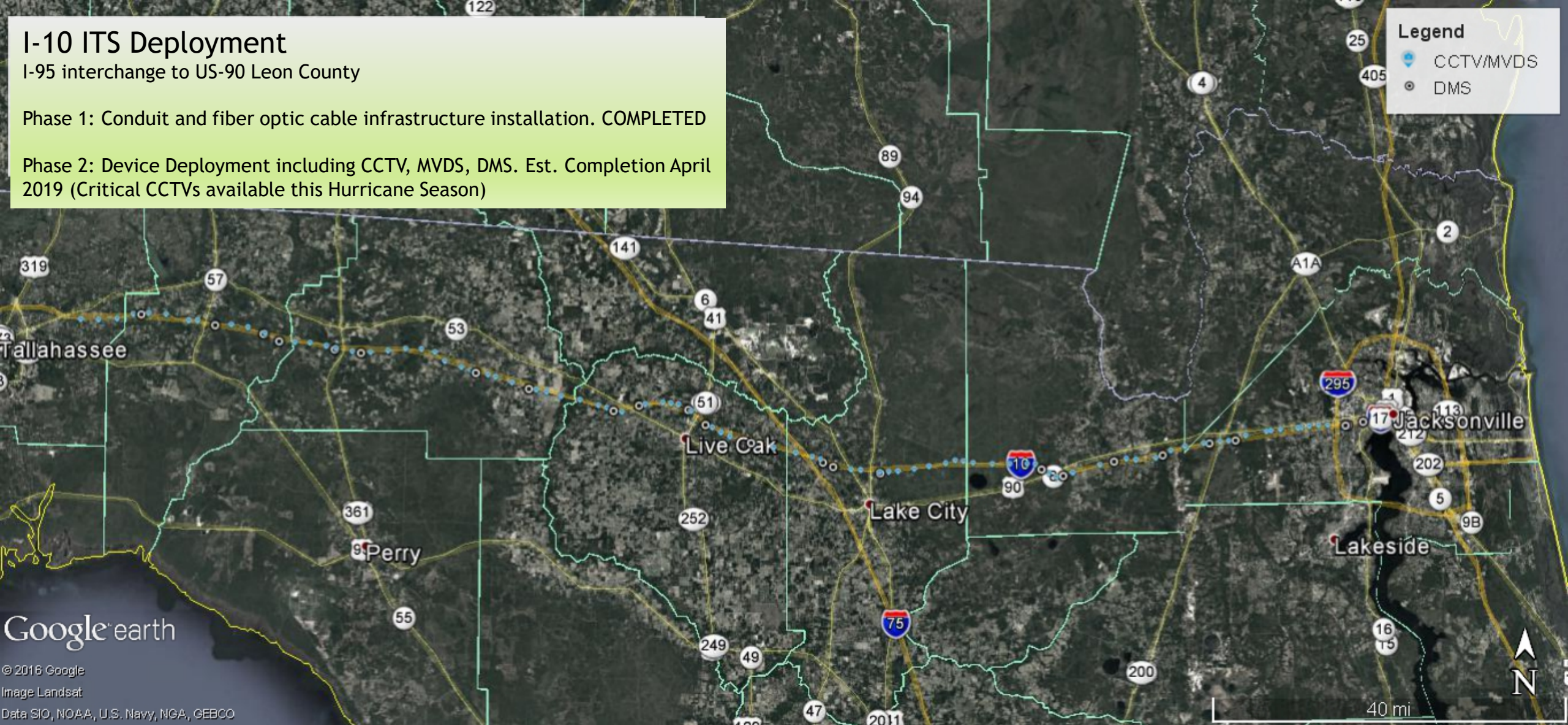

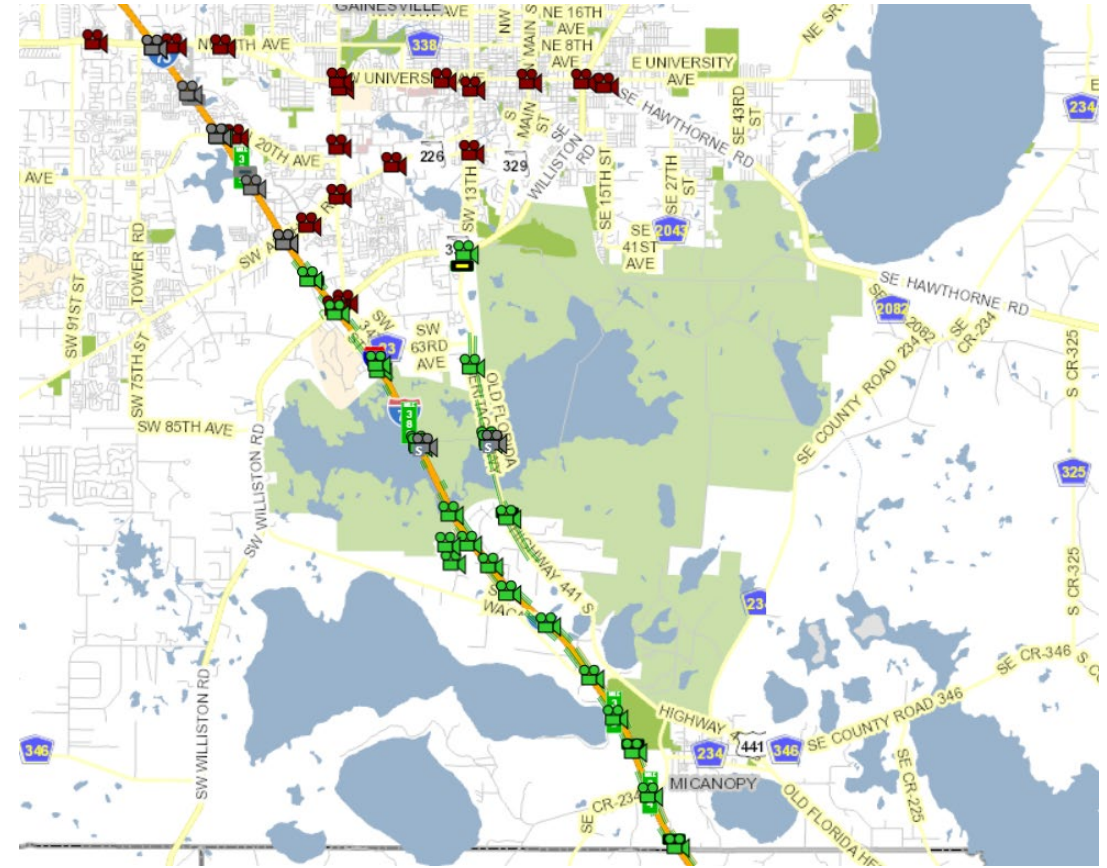

# Road Rangers



- ▶ Two routes added to Gainesville area, 2 additional to the northern end of I-75 and 2 on I-10. Primary to Gainesville on I-75:
  - ▶ SR 222 to CR 234
  - ▶ SR 24 to US-41/ US-441
- ▶ Operations to be 12 hours per day, 7 days a week in the Gainesville Area and 5 x 12 for the other 4 routes
- ▶ Safe Tow Available via RISC Lite
- ▶ Direct Benefits: reduced delay, improved safety and security, improved traffic flow, reduced potential for secondary incidents

# RISC Lite

Free Service to Motorist provided by FDOT

- ▶ Similar to RISC but for Class B Wrecker
- ▶ Staged Sun-Sat 7AM-7PM. On call Off Hours (24/7 coverage)
- ▶ Just to remove from Travel Lanes to safe location
  - ▶ Not a destination tow
- ▶ Shorter clearance times than RISC
- ▶ Activation for RISC Lite to be from Operations
  - ▶ FHP can request on shift and are only activation agency off hours
- ▶ Via the First Coast Road Ranger Contract



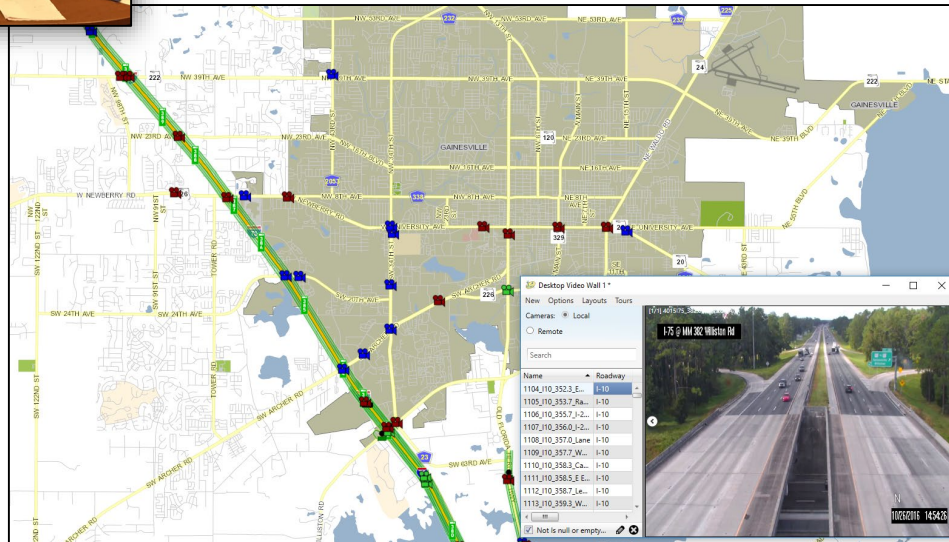

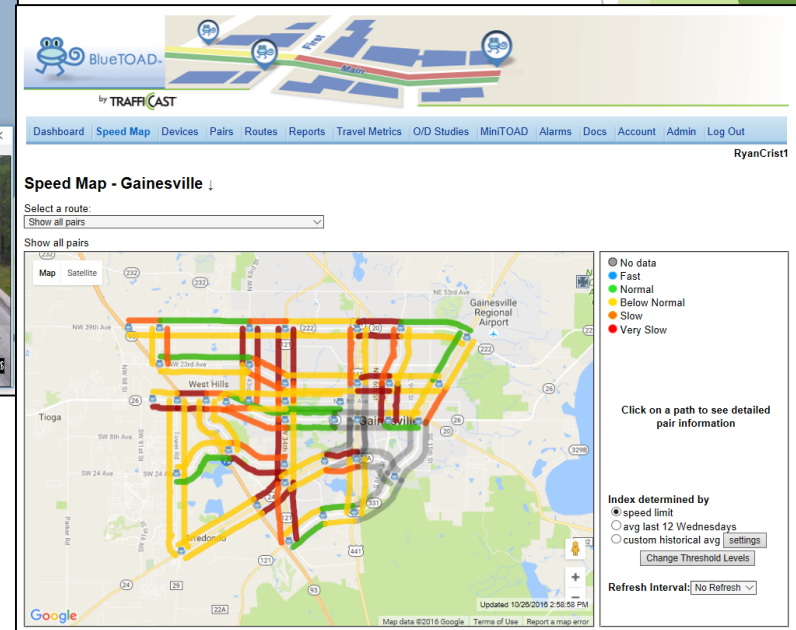
