First Coast TIM Team Meeting

Tuesday, November 27th, 2018 Meeting Minutes

Introductions and TIM Updates

- Dee Dee Crews opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Attendees introduced themselves to the group.
- The purpose of this meeting is to improve Communications, Coordination, Cooperation and Collaboration between all TIM agency partners, as well as to improve safety and congestion on the highways.
- The September 2018 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

Overland Bridge and Fuller Warren Project Update by Bill Kays with KCCS

- The Overland Bridge project is wrapping up with only ITS testing and punch-list items remaining.
- Fuller Warren project:
 - A worker lost his life working on the Fuller Warren project due to falling off a barge and drowning. It appears that he had taken his life jacket off prior to falling in the water. An investigation is ongoing.
 - Beams are being set around the FDOT Urban office which will require lane closures and detours on the night of December 13th through that weekend. This will require a detour on I-95 southbound to I-10, and motorists will be detoured off I-10 onto Forest Street.
 - The Stockton Street ramp will eventually be closed long term which will detour motorists to McDuff Avenue.
- The work on the US-17 sound wall will begin after the first of the year. The sound wall on the southbound side of the roadway has been eliminated, so it will only be installed going northbound.

Construction Project Update by Odette Struys

- The SR 9B project is on track and punch-list items are mostly completed.
- The Express Lanes from the Buckman Bridge to I-95 should be complete between February and March of 2019.
- The first phase of the First Coast Expressway should be complete by Spring 2019.
- The MLK Parkway bridge beam replacement project is now complete.

Emergency Operations Update by Ed Ward

- Hurricane Michael recovery is still ongoing in District 3. Multiple Districts have provided support.
- Dee Dee mentioned that before and after the hurricane, District 2 extended the Road Rangers to the first exit in Leon County for assistance with disabled vehicles, repairs, etc.

ITS Update/ITS Projects – 511/RTMC by Craig Carnes and Erin May

- The testing requirements and final documentation are being done for the SR 9B project,
 West Beltway, First Coast Expressway, as well as the Overland Bridge project.
- The I-10/SR 23/US 90 Interchange Project is complete.
- The I-75 project to install ITS devices from SR 24 to the Georgia line is in the testing phase as well.
- A project on I-10 to install devices from SR 23 to Tallahassee is underway.
- A recent stakeholder meeting was held for an upcoming Dames Point Bridge project. This project will install two arterial (smaller) DMS signs, both on Merrill Road approaching I-295. In the northbound direction, on I-295, there will be two large overhead DMS signs, one after you get on the bridge, and the other just as the bridge starts to incline. There will also be a large DMS sign on the southbound side as the bridge starts to incline. If anyone has any input on this project, please contact Misha Gonzales at melder@metriceng.com and she will forward the information to Craig.
- There is an upcoming stakeholder meeting on December 10th for a Talleyrand project which will connect the signals on Talleyrand Ave. to the ITS fiber. This will allow the signals to be monitored and changed if needed. The controllers will also be upgraded and DMS signs will be installed on 8th Street, 21st Street, Talleyrand Avenue, as well as MLK Parkway in each direction. Please stay after the meeting if you have any input on this project.
- Erin noted that the TMC had extra staff on duty over the Thanksgiving weekend due to the increase in motorists traveling for the holiday.
- The TMC is in the process of hiring staff for the Express Lanes.

Road Ranger Expansion Update by Dee Dee Crews

- The recent addition of Road Rangers to the west portion of I-10 took us from 8 Road Ranger patrols to 16 currently.
- The Road Rangers will be expanding again once the Express Lanes open. A stationed Road Ranger and FHP officer will be there 24/7 for the first 90 days. After the 90 days, the need will be reevaluated.
- One Road Ranger will be available on the First Coast Expressway Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- An Express Lanes Incident Response Task Team will be developed. If anyone is interested
 in joining this team, please contact Dee Dee.

Incident Debrief - Ed's List by Team Members

The Team discussed the following:

- Jorgensen was responding to an incident on SR 200 and got caught between the barrier walls and could not get to the incident. They had to send someone else on a 60 plus mile detour
- Dee Dee went through the list citing several long duration incidents to encourage attendees to discuss the incidents.
- The Team discussed an incident in D5 that caused issues in District 2. The District 2 TMC was not notified by District 5 for several hours.
- Vince Serrano brought up the incident on I-10 eastbound at Lennox Ave. Gerald Smith discussed what occurred as part of the incident.

Performance Measures by Sherrell Lall

• Sherrell provided the team with a Performance Measures presentation.

Incident Review by Gerald Smith with Jorgensen

- Gerald discussed meeting the 90-minute Open Roads Policy and publicizing the Move Over Law. He described how dangerous it can be to work these scenes. Dee Dee and Craig stressed that safety is the main concern, but that the 90-minute Open Roads Policy should be the goal.
- Greg Gaylord discussed the naming of the Congress Avenue overpass in District 4 in honor of a tow operator, Richard Jason Randolph, who perished while working an incident last year.

Express Lanes Update by Dee Dee Crews

- The I-295 West Beltway Express Lanes will open in late Fall.
- Dee Dee will be setting up a meeting with responder agencies to discuss handling incidents within the Express Lanes.

Open Forum

 Annaleasa Winter with the Florida Forest Service noted that prescribed burns will start soon throughout the area. The District has a large goal related to the acreage to have prescribed burns. Last year was wet and made it hard to burn as much as they would have liked.
