

# Alachua/Bradford TIM Team Meeting

## June 12, 2019



### Meeting Minutes

#### **Introductions and TIM Updates provided by Craig Carnes**

- Craig Carnes opened the meeting and welcomed everyone. Dee Dee Crews was unable to attend due to a training session.
- The purpose of this meeting is to improve Communications, Coordination, Cooperation and Collaboration between all TIM agency partners, as well as to improve safety and congestion on the highways.
- Attendees introduced themselves to the group.
- The April Alachua/Bradford TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously and stand as approved.

#### **Emergency Operations Update provided by Ed Ward**

- Ed was also unable to attend due to training. He relayed that the EOC is currently preparing for hurricane season.

#### **ITS Update provided by Craig Carnes**

- The I-75 ITS Project is complete up to the Georgia line. There is now ITS coverage from the Marion County line all the way north to the Georgia state line.
- The I-10 Project from SR 23 to Tallahassee is still under construction. CCTVs are operational from Jacksonville to I-10 and are being monitored by the RTMC. The remaining devices are being installed. These devices include CCTVs from I-75 to Tallahassee, and DMS and MVDS throughout the corridor.
- The I-95 Nassau County project is wrapping up. This project will extend ITS coverage up to the Georgia line.

## Incident Debrief

*Craig encouraged the Team to discuss the incidents on the list. There were only two incidents on the list since the last meeting, and no one in attendance during this TIM Team meeting was present during either incident.*

## Road Rangers Update provided by Greg Gaylord

- Road Rangers are patrolling I-75 in the Gainesville area 7 days a week.
- Steve Scanlan mentioned an incident where a Road Ranger had their sign board up but Steve did not see an incident. This was north of the Santa Fe River. Greg noted that this could have been due to the incident having just been cleared.

## Agency Reviews/Open Forum

- Steve Scanlan mentioned the truck route around Starke will be completed by Summer.
- Resurfacing of SR 100 from US 301 to the county line will be starting soon.
- The SR 20 widening project from Hawthorne into Putnam County is nearing completion.
- The project to modify the I-75 Interchange at Archer Rd. recently started.
- The Newberry Rd. Interchange has been delayed due to some mast arm issues. It is expected to start in September.
- There is a test track on US 301 in southern Clay County just north of the Bradford County line. It is for research purposes for pavement testing and was designed as a 2-phase project. The first phase has been completed and the second phase hasn't started.
- FDOT has had some significant staff changes. They are as follows:
  - District Construction Engineer - Travis Humphries
  - Operations Engineer – Jesse Sutton
  - District Traffic Engineer – Jim Hannigan
  - District Maintenance – Carrie Stanbridge
  - Interim Director of Operations – Jerry Ausher
- Lieutenant Blair with FHP mentioned the following restructuring of personnel within FHP:
  - Captain Tierney was promoted to Major with Troop B.
  - Lieutenant Young is the acting Captain until August. After August he will transfer to Ocala.
  - Major Powell has been promoted to Chief.
  - Sergeant Long is currently the acting Lieutenant until the position is filled.
- David McIntyre with Gainesville Fire Rescue noted an increased number of recent fatalities related to panhandlers in the medians. He has been tasked with addressing pedestrian/panhandler safety.
- Craig mentioned two upcoming projects:
  - The I-75 F.R.A.M.E. project (Florida's Regional Advanced Mobility Elements) and the Trapezium project. These are both connected vehicle projects that put roadside units (RSUs) on mast arms which run into the controller cabinets, and on-board units which will be mounted within vehicles for signal phase and timing, etc. These will also incorporate pedestrian, biking, motorcycle, etc. features to help with safety.
