ITS/511/RTMC Update by Craig Carnes and Derrek Odom

- FL 511 The IVR (phone option) will still be disabled although an exact date is not known at this time.

Road Ranger Update (Road Ranger Assists) by Dee Dee Crews

- On June 20th two additional Road Rangers were added to I-75 on the weekends. This brings a total of four Road Rangers on I-75 seven days a week from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Road Ranger Assists for Alachua County:
 - In the month of May there were 476 events. 462 of those events were assisted by Road Rangers.
 - 80% of those events were disabled vehicles.
 - The other 20% were abandoned vehicles, crashes, debris, weather events, vehicle fires, and MOT.
 - $\circ\;$ In the month of June, there were 551 events. 532 of those events were assisted by Road Rangers.
 - 86% of those events were disabled vehicles.
 - The other 14% were abandoned vehicles, crashes, debris, weather events, vehicle fires, and MOT.

- In the month of July, there were 621 events. 600 of those events were assisted by Road Rangers.
 - 85% of those events were disabled vehicles.
 - The other 15% were abandoned vehicles, crashes, debris, weather events, vehicle fires, and MOT.
- This averages to Road Rangers assisting to 97% of events.

Open Forum

 Jason Levy with the Alachua County Sheriff's office asked about any upcoming in-person SHRP 2 Training courses. Dee Dee noted that because of Covid restrictions, in-person trainings are not allowed at the moment. She asked that Jason send her his email address so she can send him the information on how to provide online SHRP 2 Training courses to his agency.
