Wednesday, August 11th, 2021 Meeting Minutes

Introductions and TIM Updates

- Dee Dee Crews opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Dee Dee stated the purpose of this meeting is partnering efforts to strive to continuously reduce incident scene clearance times, deter congestion and improve safety. The objective is to exceed the open roads policy, ensuring mobility, economic prosperity, and quality of life.
- The June 2021 Alachua/Bradford TIM Team meeting minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

Emergency Operations Update by Carrie Stanbridge

- Carrie introduced Amber Brock to the Team. Amber is the new Emergency Management Coordination Officer and will be giving the Emergency Operations Updates for the TIM Team meetings moving forward. - Carrie provided the 2021 Atlantic Hurricane Season outlook. The predictions are:
 - o 15-21 named storms.
 - o 7-10 hurricanes.
 - 3-5 major hurricanes
- There has already been a tremendous amount of rainfall throughout the District with unnamed storms alone. A lot of County Roads and facilities are under water and for a period of time parts of US-19 and SR 51 were underwater. The EOC is continuously monitoring these areas.

ITS/511/RTMC Update by Craig Carnes and Jason Evans

- The ITS maintenance group is working on installing the informational display monitors at the Rest Areas throughout the entire District. Cameras will be installed as well so the displays can be monitored to make sure the content is being displayed and is correct.
- The TPAS (Truck Parking Availability System) project is coming to a close. Craig noted there are still issues, but the issues are with the product. As the project is accepted, work will continue with the manufacturer to make sure that everything under warranty is replaced and upgraded as needed. Jason also noted that the data has been live for the last week, so almost all the signs that are approaching the weigh stations and rest areas have accurate information for the amount of available parking spaces. This information is also accessible on the FL 511 website.
- The FL 511 app is still undergoing updates to make it more user friendly, more hands free, and with more voice activation/prompts to keep driver's attention on the roadway and not on their phones while they are driving.

Incident Debrief

- Dee Dee went over a few of the incidents on the incident list and encouraged the Team to talk about them.
 - The Team discussed the incident on July 7th on US 301 between Davis St. and W. Weldon St. All lanes were blocked for 3 hours due to flooding so Carrie asked if anything could be done to prevent this in the future. The drains there cannot hold the large amount of water. Jesse Sutton said they can look into this and see if anything can be done.

Performance Measures by Jason Evans

• Jason provided the Team with a Performance Measures presentation.

Road Ranger Update by Dee Dee Crews

- Road Ranger Assists for Alachua County:
 - In the month of June there were 736 events. 713 of those events were assisted by Road Rangers. 542 of those events were disabled vehicles, 72 were crashes, and the remaining events were abandoned vehicles, debris on the roadside, weather events, vehicle fires, MOT, etc.
 - In the month of July there were 697 events. 677 of those events were assisted by Road Rangers. 534 of those events were disabled vehicles, 96 were crashes, and the remaining events were abandoned vehicles, debris on the roadside, weather events, vehicle fires, MOT, etc.
 - With Hurricane Season here, Dee Dee has prepared the Road Rangers by letting them know they will be expected to work 12 hour shifts in the event of a hurricane.
