Introductions and TIM Updates

- Dee Dee Crews opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Dee Dee stated the purpose of this meeting is to improve safety on the roadways. The objective is to seek the open roads policy, insuring mobility, economic prosperity and quality of life.
- The October 2021 Alachua/Bradford TIM Team meeting minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

Emergency Operations Update by Amber Brock

- Amber provided the Team with a PowerPoint presentation of a recap of this year's Hurricane Season.

ITS/511/RTMC Update by Craig Carnes and Jason Evans

- The TPAS (Truck Parking Availability System) project is coming to a close. Craig noted there are still issues, but the issues are with the product. As the project is accepted, work will continue with the manufacturer to make sure that everything under warranty is replaced and upgraded as needed.
- Jason stated that Central Office is currently working on a large update to the FL 511 app and it will have many more hands free features.
- The TMC has been preparing for the new Express Lanes in Jacksonville that will be opening up in the next few months.

Incident Debrief

- Dee Dee encouraged the Team to discuss any of the incidents on the list, but there were no comments or questions.

Performance Measures by Derrick Odom

- Derrick provided the Team with a Performance Measures presentation.

Road Ranger Update by Dee Dee Crews

- Dee Dee thanked everyone who participated in the TIM Team Self-Assessment during the October meeting.
- Road Ranger Assists for Alachua County in August through November:
 - There were 2,389 events the Road Rangers assisted with. 188 of those events were crashes, 1,866 of those events were disabled vehicles, and 4 were vehicle fires. The remaining 331 events that were assisted by Road Rangers included abandoned vehicles, debris on the roadside, weather events, MOT, etc.

- Crash Responder Safety Week was in November and WCJB TV20 in Gainesville had a ride-along with the Road Rangers. These resulted in 2,356 impressions on Twitter, 299 impressions on Instagram, and a total reach of 3,832 on Facebook.
