# First Coast TIM Team Meeting

# Tuesday, January 19, 2021 Meeting Minutes

The list of attendees, agenda, and meeting handouts are attached to these meeting minutes.

\*For the health and safety of everyone, this meeting was held virtually to adhere to COVID-19 safety guidelines.

#### **Introductions and TIM Updates**

- Dee Dee Crews opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Dee Dee stated the purpose of this meeting is to improve Communications, Coordination, Cooperation and Collaboration between all TIM agency partners, as well as to improve safety and congestion on the highways.
- The November 2020 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

# Overland Bridge and Your 10 & 95 Project Updates by Tim Heath

- There will be no major changes to the current traffic patterns at this time.
- The improvements to the Fuller Warren Bridge are still under construction. The beams across the main channel have been set.
- The Stockton St. off-ramp from I-95 Northbound is still under construction. Decks were poured this week.
- Steel beams will be erected on I-95 Northbound at I-10 Westbound this week.
- The sound wall has been constructed on Stockton St. Ramp K (I-10 Eastbound to I-95 Southbound). There will be a slight shift to the left on Ramp K to create a new work zone in that area to complete the construction. The traffic pattern will remain the same during the day at this time but there will be nighttime lane closures and detours.

# **Construction Project Update by John Powers**

- Expect the following lane closures on SR 200:
  - Mainly Eastbound right lanes from Chester Rd. to Flora Parke Blvd. and from Barnwell Rd. to O'Neil Scott Rd.
  - o On January 20<sup>th,</sup> the Westbound right lane from O'Neil Scott Rd. to Barnwell Rd.
  - o On January 21st, from Flora Parke Blvd. to Chester Rd.
- There is an ongoing railroad project called Operation Stride that should be installed between the 18<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>. There will be a few lane closures on the 22<sup>nd</sup> at Heckscher Dr. West of Somers Rd., at US 17 South of Lawton Ave., and at Norwood Ave. South of Carlton St.

# **Emergency Operations Update by Ed Ward**

- The 2020 Hurricane Season finally ended on November 30<sup>th</sup>. This was the most active and most costly hurricane season since there has been record keeping. There were 30 named storms, 13 hurricanes, and 6 major hurricanes. 12 of the storms made landfall and that broke a record from 1916 that had 10 storms make landfall. This was the 5<sup>th</sup> season in a row that produced a Category 5 hurricane.
- FDOT is in the process of updating the Continuity of Operations Plan.

• Ed announced that this will be his last TIM Team meeting as he is retiring in March. Ed noted that he has enjoyed working with the TIM Teams for the last 18 or so years and thanked everyone for their support. Dee Dee noted that Ed will be missed and how helpful his knowledge and history have helped both TIM Teams.

## ITS Update/ITS Projects/511/TMC Updates by Craig Carnes and Jason Evans

- The Truck Parking Availability System (TPAS) Project is on hold due to a new contractor taking over.
- The I-10 Widening Project is still ongoing.
- There will be an upcoming project on the Dames Point Bridge to install 3 DMS on the bridge and 2 DMS on Merrill Road approaching I-295.
- The Buckman Bridge Project is being taken over by a new contractor as well.
- FL 511 The IVR (phone option) is still active at this time. It is scheduled to be disabled sometime in March of this year. The app has had several updates over the past year and is more user friendly.
- RTMC meetings have begun for the East Beltway Express Lanes Project. This project is scheduled to be completed early this Summer.

#### **Incident Debrief**

- Dee Dee encouraged the Team to discuss any incidents on the Incident List.
  - Richard Davis with Ferrovial Services expressed concern and feels FHP doesn't have enough time to be proactive with motorists who are speeding. He feels they are too swamped with paperwork for homicides and don't have time to patrol for speeding. Dee Dee noted that a shortage of staff could be a possible reason that Richard isn't seeing many troopers on the interstates. She said she sees them enforcing speeding motorists on I-10 when she drives to and from work. Pete mentioned reading a news article recently where FHP voiced concerns about being short staffed and made a request to Florida Legislature to get more money to retain officers and to fill the vacancies.

### Road Ranger Update by Dee Dee Crews

- Road Ranger Assists for Duval, St. Johns, and Nassau Counties:
  - In the months of November and December there were 4,999 events. 4,615 of those events were assisted by Road Rangers.
    - 1,047 of those events were crashes.
    - 2,874 of those events were disabled vehicles.
    - The remaining events that were assisted by Road Rangers include abandoned vehicles, crashes, debris on the roadside, weather events, vehicle fires, police activity, MOT, etc.
- The First Coast Road Rangers vehicles are "Going Green" and will be converted to run on propane. The entire Jacksonville fleet should be converted by the end of January. The vehicles will be able to fill up their propane tanks at their shops on Boote Blvd. and Philips

- Hwy. The vehicles in Gainesville will also be converted once permitting issues at their shops are resolved.
- There are Road Rangers patrolling 24/7 on I-295, I-95 and I-10. There are also 2 Road Ranger routes that have been added 24/7 on I-75.
- Marshall Adkison mentioned that there will be Road Ranger trucks that say the word "Supervisor" on them. They will not be working; they will be out patrolling just to watch their employees.
- Richard Davis thanked the Road Rangers for helping his wife when she had a tire blow out.
