First Coast TIM Team Meeting

Tuesday, July 20, 2021 Meeting Minutes

*For the health and safety of everyone, this meeting was held virtually to adhere to COVID-19 safety guidelines.

Introductions and TIM Updates

- Dee Dee Crews opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Dee Dee stated the purpose of this meeting is for all our team partners to partner together to continue to reduce incident clearance times, to help with congestion and improve safety. Through this cooperation and communication, we hope to reduce our incident clearance times.
- The May 2021 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

Overland Bridge and Your 10 & 95 Project Updates by Tim Heath

- Detours will continue on I-95 Northbound and I-95 Southbound for the erection of steel girders on Ramp T.
- The Fuller Warren Bridge is still under construction for widening.

Construction Project Update by Hampton Ray

- Hampton thanked everyone for their help this past weekend with the finger joint rehabilitation on the Buckman Bridge. The work was completed sooner than expected. The Department has been trying to notify people in the community that if they are traveling the Buckman Bridge at any point in the next 5 weekends or so to expect double lane closures in the Southbound direction.
- There will be an overnight closure on I-10 from the First Coast Expressway to US 301 tonight and tomorrow night.

ITS Update/ITS Projects/511/TMC Updates by Craig Carnes and Derrick Odom

- The TPAS (Truck Parking Availability System) project is coming to a close. Craig noted there are still issues, but the issues are with the product. As the project is accepted, work will continue with the manufacturer to make sure that everything under warranty is replaced and upgraded as needed.
- The East Beltway Express Lanes project is expected to be completed and open in the October timeframe. The MVDS will need to be tested for accuracy and to make sure they are operational before the lanes open. A 50 car test run will be done just like it was done for the West Beltway Express Lanes before they opened.
- The live stream cameras are no longer available to view on the app. However, live stream videos can still be seen on www.FL511.com.
- The TMC has the ability to put events like flooding, etc. on state roads into FL 511 through a system called ERS (Event Reporting System). These events will show up on the incident reports.

Incident Debrief

- Dee Dee encouraged the Team to discuss any of the incidents on the list, but the Team had no comments or questions.
- Richard Davis voiced his concern regarding not getting notified of fatalities or getting late notice. He also voiced concern regarding some wrecker drivers putting down oil dry and also leaving car parts, etc. Jason said he would check into the issue with the fatalities.

Performance Measures by Jason Evans

Jason provided the Team with a Performance Measures presentation.

Incident Review Presentation by Jimmy Maly with Jorgensen

Jimmy provided the Team with an Incident Review presentation.

Road Ranger Update by Dee Dee Crews

- For the months of May and June there were 4,855 events. 4,557 of those events were assisted by Road Rangers. 2,789 of those events were disabled vehicles, 1,078 were crashes, and the remaining events were abandoned vehicles, debris on the roadside, weather events, vehicle fires, MOT, etc.
- A new Road Ranger route began yesterday, and it's being called the Matthews Bridge Arlington Expressway route. It is a Class B wrecker and is outfitted like a normal Road Ranger truck. The route will only run peak hours from 6:30 AM to 10:30 AM and 2:30 PM to 6:30 PM Monday through Friday. The route begins at Martin Luther Parkway at I-95. It goes Eastbound, then turns South onto the Arlington Expressway, then goes East on the Arlington Expressway over the Matthews Bridge and ends at Southside Blvd. where it will turn around and head back towards I-95. Nothing West of I-95 and Martin Luther King will be covered, nothing West of Martin Luther King on the Arlington Expressway will be covered, and nothing east of Southside Blvd. will be covered.

Hurricane Elsa Update by RTMC Staff

- The RTMC had extra staff on hand during the week including overnight shifts Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday in case any major events occurred. Wednesday evening was the busiest time due to a few flooding events. The major one was on I-295 on the North and East beltway at I-95 and lasted over 11 hours. Other than that, things went smoothly with no major issues. One overnight Road Ranger was added in the Western part of District 2 because it was supposed to have more of the winds and rains.
- Carrie Stanbridge passed along the following update for Dee Dee to read to the Team: Tropical Storm Elsa was a great learning curve and all things considered everything went really well. Damage was limited to the local localized flooding and downed trees caused by wind and rain, as well as saturated ground and debris. The only major issue was a tree limb falling due to the wind on US 17 causing the one fatality related to the storm. District 2 did activate the staff at the District EOC in Lake City.
