

# First Coast TIM Team Meeting

## Tuesday, November 16, 2021

### Meeting Minutes

*The list of attendees, agenda, and meeting handouts are attached to these meeting minutes.*

***\*For the health and safety of everyone, this meeting was held virtually to adhere to COVID-19 safety guidelines.***

#### **Introductions and TIM Updates**

- Dee Dee Crews opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Dee Dee stated the purpose of the meeting is to partner together to reduce incident scene clearance times, to deter congestion, and improve safety for everyone on the roadway.
- The September 2021 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

#### **Overland Bridge and Your 10 & 95 Project Updates by Tim Heath**

- Median and overhead sign foundation work is being done on the Fuller Warren Bridge.
- Decorative hand railing is being installed on the Shared Use Path (Pedestrian Bridge).
- Work is continuing on the Ramp T Bridge (I-95 Northbound to I-10 Westbound). Overhead trusses will be erected Northbound to I-10 Westbound in the left lane with no daytime lane closures anticipated.
- Nighttime lane closures will continue for I-95 Southbound and I-95 Northbound, I-10 Eastbound and I-10 Westbound, and Ramp T.

#### **Construction Project Update by Hampton Ray**

- The I-295 East Beltway Express Lanes are expected to open in mid to late December or early January, weather permitting.

#### **Emergency Operations Update by Amber Brock**

- Everything is quiet in the tropics and Hurricane Season ends in two weeks.

#### **Maintenance Operations Update by Carrie Stanbridge**

- DBi closed it's doors on October 22<sup>nd</sup> and that effectively stopped 17 asset maintenance contracts Statewide. District 2 is affected by 3 very specific contracts, the Bradford County asset maintenance contract, the I-10/I-75 Interstate West contract (which includes bridges), and the Districtwide Rest Areas. This has resulted in FDOT taking that work back in-house and with expanded supplemental contracts for things like guardrails, maintenance of traffic, tree trimming, etc.
- Carrie asked the Team for feedback on any issues they may have had or if anyone needs anything at all.

#### **ITS Update/ITS Projects/511/TMC Updates by Craig Carnes and Jason Evans**

- The TPAS (Truck Parking Availability System) project is coming to a close. Craig noted there are still issues, but the issues are with the product. As the project is accepted, work will continue with the manufacturer to make sure that everything under warranty is replaced and upgraded as needed.

- The I-295/I-95 North Interchange project is progressing. There were some issues with fiber, but work is being done with the CEI team and contractor to get that fiber replaced.
- The I-10 Widening project design is complete.
- The East Beltway Express Lanes tolling will most likely start after the new year.
- Central Office is currently in the process of a major update to the FL 511 app. The big push right now is to make the app as hands free as possible to make it safer to use while driving.
- The TPAS data will also be available on FL 511.

### **Performance Measures Presentation by Jason Evans**

- Jason provided the Team a Performance Measures presentation.

### **Incident Review Presentation by Gerald Smith**

- Gerald provided the Team with an Incident Review presentation.

### **Incident Debrief**

- Dee Dee encouraged the Team to discuss any of the incidents on the list, but there were no comments or questions.

### **Road Rangers Update by Dee Dee Crews**

- Road Ranger Assists for Duval County:
  - In the months of September and October there were 5,000 events. 1,110 of those events were crashes, 3,061 of those events were disabled vehicles, and 11 were vehicle fires. The remaining events that were assisted by Road Rangers included abandoned vehicles, debris on the roadside, weather events, MOT, etc.
- Road Ranger Assists for St. Johns County:
  - In the months of September and October there were 302 events. 48 of those events were crashes, 214 of those events were disabled vehicles, and 2 were vehicle fires. The remaining events that were assisted by Road Rangers included abandoned vehicles, debris on the roadside, weather events, MOT, etc.
- Road Ranger Assists for Nassau County:
  - In the months of September and October there were 123 events. 8 of those events were crashes, 9 of those events were disabled vehicles, and 2 were vehicle fires. The remaining events that were assisted by Road Rangers included abandoned vehicles, debris on the roadside, weather events, MOT, etc.
- A Road Ranger will patrol the East Beltway Express Lanes. The RISC Lite vehicle will service both East and West Beltways, so a new wrecker will not be added. The Road Ranger will patrol the East Beltway Express Lanes Monday through Friday 6 AM to 7 PM (the same hours as the Road Ranger in the West Beltway Express Lanes).

### **Announcements**

- Crash Responder Safety Week was last week and Katie Jeffries with First Coast News did a great spot highlighting it. WCJB TV20 in Gainesville had a ride-along with the Road Rangers. These resulted in 2,356 impressions on Twitter, 299 impressions on Instagram, and a total reach of 3,832 on Facebook.
- The TIM Team Self-Assessment has been submitted and the evaluation should be provided in the next month. Once the evaluation comes back Dee Dee will provide the Team with the results.

- The next meeting is scheduled for January 18<sup>th</sup> at 10 a.m. and will still be held virtually at this time. Updates for in person meetings will be sent out with the TIM Team meeting reminders.
