Introductions and TIM Updates

- Dee Dee Crews opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Dee Dee stated the purpose of this meeting is to have coordination and partnering efforts to reduce incident clearance times, detour congestion, and to improve safety of all our partners on the roadways.
- The December 2021 Alachua/Bradford TIM Team meeting minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

Emergency Operations Update by Amber Brock

- The EOC is continuing to prepare for Hurricane Season.

Maintenance Operations Update by Carrie Stanbridge

- The new asset maintenance contractor for I-75 and I-10 on the Westside of the District is DeAngelo Contracting Services, also known as D.C.S.
- The new asset maintenance contractor for the rest areas, weigh stations, and Welcome Centers is Ferrovial Services.
- Beams will be replaced on I-75 over US 441 in Lake City starting today. US 441 will be reduced to one lane in each direction, and I-75 Northbound will be reduced from three lanes to two lanes. The outside lane and shoulder Northbound will be closed. The new beams should be put up in 30 days, but the whole process will take close to 60 days total.

ITS/511/RTMC Update by Jason Evans

- The TPAS (Truck Parking Availability System) project is coming to a close. Jason noted there are still issues, but the issues are with the product. As the project is accepted, work will continue with the manufacturer to make sure that everything under warranty is replaced and upgraded as needed. The RTMC has been doing manual counts to ensure the signs are as accurate as possible.
- Jason stated that Central Office is currently working on a large update to the FL 511 app and it will have many more hands free features.

Performance Measures by Jason Evans

- Jason provided the Team with a Performance Measures presentation.

Incident Debrief

- Dee Dee encouraged the Team to discuss any of the incidents on the list, but there were no comments or questions.

Road Ranger Update by Dee Dee Crews

- Road Ranger Assists for Alachua County in December through January:
 - The Road Rangers assisted with 992 events. 62 of those events were crashes, 774 of those events were disabled vehicles, and the remaining events included vehicle fires, abandoned vehicles, debris on the roadside, weather events, MOT, etc.
 - The Road Rangers responded to 98% of the events in the Alachua County area.
- Dee Dee reminded the Team that there is a RISC Lite truck available on I-75 in Alachua County. They are on duty 7 days a week from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., and then on call from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. if they are requested by FHP.
