# Alachua Bradford TIM Team Meeting Wednesday, June 14<sup>th</sup>,2023 Meeting Minutes

## Introductions and TIM Updates

- Dee Dee Crews opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Dee Dee stated the purpose of this meeting is to gather everybody together to coordinate and improve cooperation to clear the roadways sooner for everyone's safety and try to figure out ways to improve our roadway clearance times.
- The April Alachua/Bradford TIM Team meeting minutes were sent to the Team previously, with Lola Butler having one addition.
  - 2023 Emergency Shoulder Use Plans are updated and available on the FDOT D2 SharePoint site, for anyone who has access to it.

### **Emergency Operations Update by Lola Butler**

- Hurricane Season started June 1<sup>st</sup>
  - The EOC team has been going around performing hurricane exercises and meeting with different areas, including asset maintenance
- The EOC has implemented a new SitReps template, and will be sending out to asset maintenance
- Lola encourages anyone who does have access to the FDOT D2 SharePoint site to take a look at it because there is very valuable information in there
  - $\circ~$  Currently developing new teams, and will be reaching out to everyone to ensure they know their role in the case of an emergency
- It is predicted that this hurricane season will be less active than in the past
  - Encourages everyone to keep their plans up to date in the case of a major storm
- All plans have been updated, all units have sent in new and revised plans which are uploaded into the SharePoint

#### Maintenance Operations Update by Lola Butler

- Continued upgrades at various rest areas
  - Work activities include replacement of tanks at some wastewater treatment plants, replacement of flooring, exterior and interior painting, and landscaping.
    - This is not all-inclusive, nor will it occur at all facilities
- Repair and replacement of I-10 bridge joint in Madison County to begin the weekend of June 19<sup>th</sup>
  - This will require one lane of I-10 to close 24/7, for up to 2 weeks
  - Hopeful that this work will be completed in 6-10 days
- Increased attention to trails and the Shared Use Path Bridge
  - Looking into quantifying inventory for this infrastructure, such as maintenance concerns, calls, and life cycles to see how it can be managed through maintenance agreements, grants, and local programs
- Currently at the end of the Fiscal Year and are working through the budget allocations for the 23-24 Fiscal Year
  - Looking at 5-10% reduction in maintenance budget

- Carrie appreciates the work that asset maintenance has completed and is doing along I-10 and I-75 corridors, related to tree trimming, removal of dead and leaning trees, and reclaiming the ditch line ahead of the storm season as they need the capacity in the ditches to take on the water.
- Look for upcoming meetings for pertinent parties to discuss ESU along I-10 and I-75

# ITS/511/RTMC Update by Jason Evans

- New CCTV camera and detector on I-75 NB exit ramp to Williston Road
- New Rest Area at the Suwannee Columbia line is opened, with truck parking activated last week
- Pushing the FL511 app as we are into hurricane season, which will be helpful in the case of evacuations that may need to take place
- The RTMC is still working towards getting prepped for hurricane season
  - Generators are tested, all devices are online, perishable foods are in stock and RTMC is good for a week in case the staff needs to stay

#### **Open Forum**

- General comment regarding wrecker drivers leaving material on arterial roadways after an event

  - If law enforcement is still on scene when the tow trucks arrived, a gentle reminder should be given to the wreckers to ensure debris is removed from the roadways
