Meeting Minutes

The list of attendees, agenda, and meeting handouts are attached to these meeting minutes.

Introductions and TIM Updates

- Dee Dee Crews opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Dee Dee stated the purpose of the meeting is to partner together to reduce incident scene clearance times, deter congestion, and improve safety for everyone on the roadway.
- The March First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

Construction Project Update: Hampton Ray

- The I-295/I-95 northern interchange recently opened two additional lanes of traffic for smoother flow.
 - There will be several traffic shifts for this project in the coming months.
 - Construction will be taking place for at least another year, with an estimated completion date of Spring 2025.
- The I-295 at US-17 interchange will see ramp detours for the coming weeks.
- Please reach out to Hampton Ray if there are any questions regarding the I-295/I-95 northern interchange, the I-295 at US-17 interchange, or I-10 detours.

Emergency Operations Update: Jason Evans

- The 2024 Hurricane Season will go from 6/1/2024 through 11/30/2024.
 - Colorado State University is predicting an extremely active Atlantic Hurricane season.
 - Coverage areas for the prediction includes the Atlantic Ocean, the Gulf of Mexico, and the Caribbean
 - The Team forecasted 23 named storms, including 11 hurricanes.
 - Five of these 11 hurricanes are predicted to be Category 3 or greater.

Maintenance Operations Update: Jason Evans

- The recent storms that blew through the county took down a lot of trees along I-295, with cleanup scheduled to be completed by the end of May.

ITS Update/ITS Projects/511/TMC Updates: Craig Carnes/Peter Vega/Jason Evans

- Craig advised that there are several ongoing projects throughout the District 2 region. The ITS Group works in close coordination with all projects to ensure the Fiber Optic Cable infrastructure is not damaged at any point in the construction process.
 - The Buckman Bridge ATMS project is still ongoing.
 - The I-10 widening project has been going smoothly, with no recent fiber cuts or power outages.
 - There are two new MLK Parkway projects, one of which is at the I-95 Interchange, to address the issues of trucks hitting the bridge. The second project is to the east of the Interchange Project.
 - I-95 widening project from Emerson to Atlantic

- The DMS within the project limits will need to be removed, so the RTMC is working to get a temporary DMS installed.
- Peter Vega reminded the team that all CCTV cameras in the State can be accessed through FL511.
- Jason Evans advised the FL511 app is continuing to improve, and they are in the early stages of testing expansion for Connected Vehicle and Emergency Vehicle applications for the app.
 - The pilot project is currently ongoing in District 5.
- Hurricane season is quickly approaching and the RTMC is taking precautions to ensure their supplies are ready and documentation is up to date.

Performance Measures Presentation: Arianna Franklin/James Maly

- Arianna Franklin and James Maly provided the Team with the Performance Measures Presentation

Incident List: Team

- The changes to the incident list were discussed, including the addition of a HAZMAT column, and changing the “Deaths” column to a Traffic Homicide Investigation (THI)/Serious Bodily Injury (SBI) column.
- Of the 58 total events found on the incident list, 21 of them were SBI/THI investigations, leading to higher incident durations.
- Only 12 of the incidents met the 90-minute Open Roads Duration goal.
- Three events were highlighted for further discussion, including:
 - Event #18 - 4/3/2024 - Police Activity - I-10 WB at McDuff Ave, Emergency Vehicles responding to a crash on the EB side, barrier wall damaged and pushed, all WB lanes blocked.
 - Wet and rainy, FedEx truck on top of barrier wall in construction area
 - Notes from Gerald –
 - Nine temporary barrier walls had to be replaced, which took over two hours. The roadway was not safe to open without the temporary barrier walls.
 - Event #29 - 4/18/2024 - Accident - I-10 WB at MM 315, single vehicle crash involving a semi versus construction equipment (tanker truck), all WB lanes blocked.
 - Dry and clear
 - Per FHP, construction MOT was beginning to block the left lane when a semi ran into the tanker truck.
 - The first two wreckers in the rotation that were called were unavailable, contributing to the higher incident duration.
 - Event #52 - 5/4/2024 - Accident - I-10 WB at Lenox Ave, two vehicle crash with injuries involving an overturned vehicle, all WB lanes blocked.
 - ASAP towing had to separate the semi-truck in two as it was badly damaged, contributing to the delay.
