First Coast TIM Team Meeting

Tuesday, September 17th, 2024

Meeting Minutes

The list of attendees, agenda, and meeting handouts are attached to these meeting minutes.

Introductions and TIM Updates

- Jason Evans opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Jason Evans stated the purpose of the meeting is to partner together to reduce incident scene clearance times, deter congestion, and improve safety for everyone on the roadway.
- The July First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

Construction Project Update: Hampton Ray

- There will be ongoing ramp closures as part of the ongoing I-295 at Normandy Boulevard project.
- There will also be significant lane shifts on I-95 from Atlantic Boulevard to Emerson Street
 - The next step in construction will be removing the sound walls and pushing them out.
 - Hampton expects to receive a lot of feedback from the community.
- Pete advised the Team to call the RTMC regarding any potential water build up in work zones.

Emergency/Maintenance Operations Update: Jason Evans

- Continuing debris removal operations in western part of D2, including Lafayette, Madison, Hamilton, Suwannee, Dixie, and Taylor Counties
 - Debris removal was completed in October 2024
- Emergency Construction Contracts were awarded to Superior Construction to fix the I-95 at Airport Road/Max Leggett Pkwy Bridge Hit
 - There will be ongoing lane closures while they complete the beam replacement.
- There was a significant lane closure on A1A at Amelia Island, near the golf club pedestrian overpass where a lengthy detour was set in place.
 - This detour was scheduled between the Amelia Island Jazz Festival and the Florida/Georgia football game.
 - This is a joint County and Golf Course Project

ITS Update/ITS Projects/511/TMC Updates: Craig Carnes/Jason Evans

- Craig Carnes stated that there are several ongoing projects throughout the District 2 region, including the continuation of the Buckman Bridge ATMS project, the two MLK projects, and the I-295/I-95 northern interchange project.
 - The ITS group works in close coordination with all projects to ensure the Fiber Optic Cable infrastructure is not damaged at any point in the construction process.
- Peter Vega then discussed the SMART St. Augustine project, which aims to make the City of St. Augustine more pedestrian/bicyclist friendly.
- The bridge sensors and the Road Weather Information System (RWIS) sensors throughout the District are in the process of being replaced.

- Jason Evans reminded the team to update their FL511 apps as they are still working to improve the hands-free features.

Performance Measures Presentation: Taylor Rouse/James Maly

- Taylor Rouse and James Maly provided the Team with the Performance Measures Presentation

Incident List: Team

- Of the 57 total events found on the incident list, 13 of them were SBI/THI investigations, leading to higher incident durations.
- 19 of the 57 incidents met the 90-minute Open Roads Duration goal.
- Three events were highlighted for further discussion, including:
 - Event #12 – 7/23/2024 – Vehicle Fire - I-295 W SB before Duval Rd, Single-vehicle crash involving a construction truck carrying Acetylene on Fire, HAZMAT response, all SB lanes blocked.
 - HAZMAT was required because the vehicle was a striping truck, and materials inside burned up so there was nothing to clean, just needed for removal.
 - Event #51 - 9/1/2024 - Accident - I-95 NB at MM 348 - Two-vehicle crash with injuries involving a Wrong Way Driver, 2 Right Lanes Blocked
 - Event #52 - 9/1/2024 - Accident - I-95 NB at MM 348 - Two-vehicle crash with injuries involving a motorcycle and SUV, All NB Lanes Blocked - Secondary to Event #51
 - TMC was not aware that this was a Wrong Way Driver until after the event was cleared.
