# First Coast TIM Team Meeting

## Tuesday, July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024

### Meeting Minutes

#### **Introductions and TIM Updates**

- Dee Dee Crews opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Dee Dee stated the purpose of the meeting is to partner together to reduce incident scene clearance times, deter congestion, and improve safety for everyone on the roadway.
- The May First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

#### **Construction Project Update: Hampton Ray**

- I-10 resurfacing project from I-95 to the Nassau County Line is experiencing ongoing ramp closures and traffic shifts
  - Striping for I-10 at US-301 is anticipated to take place in the coming week for multiple ramps
    - Construction should be completed within the next 30-60 days and punch list items are being finalized
- The JTB at Kernan Blvd interchange will have ongoing ramp closures
- Signage concerns for the I-295 north interchange at I-95 were raised, specifically on I-295 in either direction
  - A team is looking into these concerns to see if any operational improvements can be made
  - Construction will be taking place for at least another year

#### **Emergency Operations Update: Jason Evans**

- FDOT continues debris removal operations due to the tornadoes in the western part of the District
  - Cleanup in Taylor County has been completed
  - Cleanup in Suwannee County is anticipated to be completed within the week (Week ending Sunday, July 21<sup>st</sup>)
- The following Emergency Shoulder Use (ESU) Plans updates were provided:
  - I-95 ESU will end at SR-9B and will not extend through the City of Jacksonville to the Georgia State Line
  - I-75 ESU will end south of I-10 and will not extend to the Georgia State Line
  - I-10 ESU – there are several ongoing resurfacing projects throughout the I-10 corridor in District 2
    - There is constant coordination of shoulder conditions and pinch points due to new construction

#### **Maintenance Operations Update: Jason Evans**

- New “Welcome to Florida” / “Leaving Florida” signs were installed and uncovered prior to the 4<sup>th</sup> of July
- Maintenance is currently awaiting guidance on Jimmy Buffet Highway signs along A1A
  - It is understood that two (2) signs per county will be placed

- They have received complaints of the striping coming up on the Fuller Warren new Shared Use Path
  - The contractor is to repaint the stripes. Daytime closures will occur
- Skate Park under the Fuller Warren Bridge
  - Maintenance is working with FHWA on Break in Access to limited Access ROW Interstate Facility, FHWA has approved and is currently circulating the lease agreement for final signatures
    - Note: this facility is NOT OPEN to the public. Security checks and citations have been issued.

### **ITS Update/ITS Projects/511/TMC Updates: Jason Evans**

- WWD Devices are being installed on I-95 @ SR-207 and I-95 @ International Golf Parkway
- Rail detection is being expanded
  - The RTMC has included several rail crossings along US 17 that in the future, will tie into the existing ITS network
    - When crossing arms are down, the DMS along the corridor can inform motorists that arms are down, giving them the option to either seek alternative routes, or to be aware that there will be a delay
    - This system will be tied into FL511 as well
- The RTMC has completed their hurricane prep checklist, which includes stocking up on batteries and food, completing generator tests, and ensuring sleeping arrangements within the RTMC/NFTPO building are in place

### **Performance Measures Presentation: Taylor Rouse/James Maly**

- Taylor Rouse and James Maly provided the Team with the Performance Measures Presentation

### **Incident List: Team**

- Of the 49 total events found on the incident list, 18 of them were SBI/THI investigations, leading to higher incident durations.
- 17 of the incidents met the 90-minute Open Roads Duration goal.
- Two events were highlighted for further discussion, including:
  - Event #4 - 5/18/2024 - Police Activity - I-10 EB at Ramp to I-295 W NB, Police activity in reference to a shooting, ramp closed
    - This resulted from a deceased body that was found in a vehicle in the treeline
  - Event #31 - 6/21/2024 - Crash - SR-115/Arlington Expy WB at Mathews Bridge, 2 vehicle crash with injuries, all WB lanes blocked
