Introductions and TIM Updates

- Lacey Collins opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- Lacey Collins stated the purpose of the meeting is to partner together to reduce incident scene clearance times, deter congestion, and improve safety for everyone on the roadway.
- The June 2025 Alachua/Bradford TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

TIM Discussion: Lacey Collins

- Struck By Incident statistics for 2024 and 2025
 - Since the last TIM meeting in April, 2 Law Enforcement Officers and 2 Tow truck operators were struck and killed.
 - One officer was struck and killed in Texas while working a funeral procession.
- How can we reduce struck by incidents?
 - TIM team watched Pi-Lit video and how it is used for road blocking events
- Electric Vehicle Fires
 - TIM team watched video presented by FireOne on what to do when an electric vehicle catches fire
- FLHSMV back to school checklist:
 - Buckle up and choose the right seat
 - Stop for school buses
 - Slow down in school zones
 - Look out before you step out
 - Check for kids
- August 13 through September 1: Pre Labor Day Impaired Driving Enforcement

- Sarah Hipps stated they are closely monitoring Tropical storm Erin

- Upcoming Wrong Way Detection deployments:
- Exit 399 will get one installed in the next year or two

- RWIS devices are being replaced and should be completed in the next 2-3 weeks

- Lacey Collins provided the Team Performance Measures for the last two months to the Alachua/Bradford Team.

Incident Review/Debrief: Lacey Collins/Team

- Incident list provided to Team members.
- Alachua/Bradford had a total of 8 major events to review for the last two months.
- Five events did not reach the 90-minute roadway clearance goal
- Three major events were discussed
- Event #2, 06/09/2025, Alachua County, US 301 at SE 57th Ave.; Two vehicle collision involving fatality, all northbound lanes were blocked.
- Event #3, 06/24/2025, Alachua County, I-75 SB at MM394; semi-truck became fully engulfed, all southbound lanes were blocked.
- Event #6, 07/110/2024, Alachua County, SR-121 at I-75; Head-on collision involving a sedan and work van resulting in two fatalities; all southbound lanes were blocked.
