- We have installed over 30 new BlueToad devices in Alachua County
 - BlueToad is a technology used to gather data to better assist with accurate travel times, speeds, and origin/destination reporting
- Preparing at RTMC for Hurricane season
 - Checking generators, food supply, and updating emergency contacts

- Lacey Collins provided the Team Performance Measures for the last three months to the Alachua/Bradford Team

Incident Review/Debrief: Lacey Collins/Team

- Incident list provided to Team members
- Alachua/Bradford had a total of three major events to review for the last three months
- All three events occurred in Alachua County
- All three events did not reach the 90-minute roadway clearance goal, one of these incidents involved a fatality
- Event #1, 03/10/2025, Alachua County, I-75SB MM382; Single vehicle crash with injuries and a fatality, all southbound lanes were blocked
- Event #2, 03/19/2025, Alachua County, I-75SB MM375; UPS truck collided with disabled vehicle causing the UPS truck to overturn and lose it's load, all southbound lanes were blocked
- Event #3, 03/21/2024, Alachua County, I-75NB MM376; Pickup truck hauling airstream caught fire on the outside shoulder, both camper and trailer became fully engulfed, all lanes were blocked in both directions
