Introductions and TIM Updates

- Lacey Collins opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- First Coast TIM Team introduced themselves.
- Lacey Collins stated the purpose of the meeting is to partner together to reduce incident scene clearance times, deter congestion, and improve safety for everyone on the roadway.
- November 2025 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

TIM Discussion: Lacey Collins

- Struck By Incident statistics for 2024 and 2025
- Lacey Collins discussed with the team January is Move Over Month
- Responding to the future: Understanding Autonomous Vehicle Technology
 - Why it Matters to First Responders?
 - Florida is among the most active states for autonomous and connected vehicle testing
 - How Autonomous Vehicle technology works?
 - Autonomous vehicles use lidar, radar, cameras, GPS, and AI to navigate and make driving decisions
 - Not all automation is the same. There are 5 levels of driving automation
 1. No Automation
 2. Driver Assistance
 3. Partial Automation
 4. Conditional Automation
 5. High Automation
 6. Full Automation
 - Autonomous Long-Haul Trucks
 - Driverless freight trucks bring new challenges for responders managing highway crashes and lane closures
 - TIM Team watched a video of how Autonomous long haul truck testing is being used by FedEx
 - Autonomous truck mounted attenuators
 - Driverless crash trucks that are used to protect highway work zones

Construction Project Update: Bert Watson

- I-95 and I-295 north interchange is in final configuration and should end around July, unknown July 2026 or July 2027

- I-10 widening continues
- I-95 to I-295, making a lot of progress, signs are being placed, the westbound shift change is in place
- I-95 widening is still on going
- MLK overpass construction is progressing
- First Coast Expressway crews are making up time lost; the bridge span being placed over river going very well
- Bridge construction on I-95 over the Nassau River will be ending soon
- Various resurfacing projects are being completed around the First Coast area

- WWD system expansion
 - 34 systems currently active in District 2
 - 37 systems in various stages of construction
 - 23 ActiveVision Wrong Way Driver Systems implemented
- No 511 updates
- Looking to expand ActiveVision to all interstate cameras
 - 2 new servers will be installed

Performance Measures: Lacey Collins

- Lacey Collins provided the Team with the Performance Measures from November 2025 through December 2025 for the First Coast area

Incident Review: Lacey Collins/Team

- Event #16 was highlighted for further discussion:
 - 12/27/2025, Crash, I-10 WB Ramp to US-301 SB, Duval County. Semi-Truck and trailer failed to negotiate the curve resulting in the semi colliding with the guardrail and overturn. Semi-Trailer was fully loaded with cases of washer fluid. The incident lasted approximately 4 hours.

Maintenance Incident Review: Jimmy Maly

- Two events were highlighted for further discussion, including:
 - Event #26, 12/8/2025, Fatality Crash, I-10 EB at US-301, Duval County. Two vehicle collision, and one confirmed fatality. The incident lasted approximately 4.5 hours.
 - 12/11/2025, I-95 SB at MM314, St. Johns County. Semi-Truck traveled off the roadway and collided with the wood-line. There was a large debris field, and the driver was pronounced deceased on scene. The incident lasted approximately 7 hours.

Incident List Debrief: Lacey Collins/Team

- 46 Total events from November 1 through December 31
- 33 Events over 90-minute goal

RISC Debrief: Lacey Collins

- 11/21/2025, I-95 NB at MM315, St. Johns County
 - A vehicle fire involving a semi cab and trailer, the cab became fully engulfed. RISC was activated due to heavy congestion and a holiday weekend. Walt's Wrecker responded for RISC, the road was partially blocked for 2 hours and 23 minutes.
- 12/08/2025, I-10 EB at MM349, Duval County
 - Semi-Truck hauling a trailer veered off the roadway and collided with a disabled RV on the outside shoulder. Walt's Wrecker responded for RISC, multiple durations of road blockage.
- 12/23/2025, I-10 EB Ramp to I-295 SB, Duval County
 - Semi-Truck hauling a flatbed trailer loaded with metal poles overturned resulting in a loss of load. Allen's Towing responded for RISC, and all lanes were blocked for approximately 2 hours.

Open Forum: Team

- Aurora provides training for First Responders on Autonomous Vehicles
- Dee Dee Crews advised starting February 1, we will have a Class B Tow truck that will cover the bridges in Duval County, and we will have one available 24/7
- Jeff Cotter advised Parallel Systems out of California, has developed an autonomous rail car
 - Currently being tested on short lines in Ga
 - Will eventually travel 200 miles from Pooler Ga to Cordele Ga
 - Autonomous rail car will only carry shipping containers
 - Will alleviate traffic on roadways
- SHRP2 Training is available to all agencies
