# First Coast TIM Team Meeting

## Tuesday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2026

### Meeting Minutes

#### **Introductions and TIM Updates**

- Lacey Collins opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- First Coast TIM Team introduced themselves.
- Lacey Collins stated the purpose of the meeting is to partner together to reduce incident scene clearance times, deter congestion, and improve safety for everyone on the roadway.
- January 2026 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

#### **TIM Discussion: Lacey Collins**

- Struck By Incident statistics for 2025 and 2026
- Lacey Collins provided Florida Traffic Safety Overview for 2025
  - 12,840 serious injury crashes
  - 2,862 fatalities
  - 676,165 total crashes
  - Baker County had the following:
    - 19 serious injury crashes
    - 8 fatalities
    - 589 total crashes
  - Clay County had the following:
    - 87 serious injury crashes
    - 23 fatalities
    - 5,347 total crashes
  - Duval County had the following:
    - 428 serious injury crashes
    - 165 fatalities
    - 37,397 total crashes
  - Nassau County had the following:
    - 51 serious injury crashes
    - 17 fatalities
    - 1,878 total crashes
  - St. Johns County had the following:
    - 99 serious injury crashes
    - 31 fatalities
    - 7,814 total crashes
- In 2025, a total of 17,352 move over citations were issued statewide
- 2026 Wildfire Statistics: January 1 through March 1
  - Acres burned:

- State: 38,991
  - Federal: 29,470
- Number of Wildfires:
  - State: 1,095
  - Federal: 46
- Lacey Collins provided the TIM team with the current county-enacted burn bans across the First Coast area
- We have experienced heavy fog across the First Coast area over the last few weeks.
  - Drivers are encouraged to use caution due to low visibility
- National Traffic Incident Management Responder Training is being provided to all interested agencies
  - FAC15B-9 Impacts to training demands for the National TIM Responder Training Course

### **Construction Project Update: Bert Watson**

- I-95 and I-295 north interchange should be completed around May of 2026, very close to final configuration
- I-95 and MLK will be a while, lane shifts are amazing and RPMS are helping with traffic
- I-10 widening on the westbound side is in final configuration
- I-10 widening on the eastbound side is close to being completed with an end in sight
- I-95 near Emerson widening is still on going
- Sr-23 at the Shands Bridge is progressing

### **Emergency Operations Update: Sarah Hipps/Lola Butler**

- Diligently monitoring wildfires especially in Baker County

### **Maintenance Operations Update: Carrie Stanbridge/Sarah Hipps**

- Working on joints on the Acosta Bridge
- Daytime lane closures on Mathews Bridge due to maintenance

### **ITS Update/ITS Projects/511/TMC Updates: Jason Evans**

- Hurricane preparation starts in April
- Projects have slowed as we get close to the end of the fiscal year
- DMS retrofits still underway
- Activision is fully deployed across District 2
  - Training Activision to detect congestion and pedestrians on the interstate
  - Will later move toward wildlife detection and fog detection
- DMS on SR-23 are defaulting to blank, it is something that will be spread across District 2 over the next few weeks

## **Performance Measures: Lacey Collins**

- Lacey Collins provided the Team with the Performance Measures from January 2026 through February 2026 for the First Coast area

## **Incident Review: Lacey Collins/Team**

- Event #16 was highlighted for further discussion:
  - 01/16/2026, Wrong Way Driver Crash, SR-228 and Hart Bridge Expressway, Duval County. Brown Acura and Green Mini Cooper collided resulting in injuries. The incident lasted approximately 4.75 hours.
- Event #39 was highlighted for further discussion:
  - 02/19/2026, Vehicle Fire, I-95 NB at MM315, St. Johns County. Tanker truck caught fire on the right shoulder resulting in a brush fire. The incident lasted approximately 4.25 hours.

## **Maintenance Incident Review: Jimmy Maly**

- Two events were highlighted for further discussion, including:
  - Event #13, 01/14/2026, Fatality Crash, I-95 SB at MLK, Duval County. Vehicle collided with an attenuator and construction equipment, and then collided with another vehicle, and one confirmed fatality. The incident lasted approximately 5 hours.
  - Event #46, 02/26/2026, Fatality Crash, SR-9B SB at US-1, Duval County. Disabled vehicle was stopped on the interstate. A good Samaritan got out to try and assist the disabled vehicle and was struck and killed. The incident lasted approximately 5.5 hours.

## **Incident List Debrief: Lacey Collins/Team**

- 46 Total events from January 1 through February 28
- 30 Events over 90-minute goal

## **RISC Debrief: Lacey Collins**

- 01/04/2026, I-95 NB at MM306, St. Johns County
  - A semi-truck hauling an enclosed trailer loaded with cabbage collided with an SUV. Semi-truck and trailer overturned and became fully engulfed. Johns Towing responded for RISC, all lanes were blocked for 4 hours and 21 minutes.
- 01/29/2026, I-295 NB between I-10 and Commonwealth Ave, Duval County
  - Semi-Truck hauling a trailer veered off the roadway and collided with a guardrail on the inside shoulder. The semi-truck and trailer overturned

resulting in a loss of steel beams and metal panels. Walt's Wrecker responded for RISC, all lanes were blocked for 3 hours and 8 minutes.
