Meeting Minutes

Introductions and TIM Updates

- Lacey Collins opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- First Coast TIM Team introduced themselves.
- Lacey Collins stated the purpose of the meeting is to partner together to reduce incident scene clearance times, deter congestion, and improve safety for everyone on the roadway.
- March 2025 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

TIM Discussion: Lacey Collins

- Struck By Incident statistics for 2024 and 2025
- Volusia County Sheriff's Office and FHP "near" struck by incident video
- Road Ranger truck was struck on May 11 by an intoxicated driver, the road ranger was assisting on a crash at the time and sustained minor injuries.
- TIM Team will be conducting National Traffic Incident Management Responder Training in the future
- TIM Team discussed Wrong Way Driver Devices and how they work in our First Coast Area
 - 42 Wrong Way Driver Devices
 - Provided list of new locations for Wrong Way Driver Devices
- Hurricane Season is approaching and will begin June 1st
 - Early predications estimate 17 named storms, 9 named hurricanes, and 4 major hurricanes
 - ESU Corridors: I-10 westbound from US-301 to US-319; I-95 northbound from SR-706 to SR-9B; I-75 northbound from SR-951 to I-10
- TIM Team watched a video on how Emergency Shoulder Use works in the state of Florida
- D2 ESU Implementation flow chart
- Provided TIM Team with possible sign's they might see if ESU is implemented

Construction Project Update:

- No update at this time (public speaker was unable to attend)

Emergency/Maintenance Operations Update: Lola Butler

- District 2 DOT coordinates with governor to implement ESU, it begins at the local level and then informs them whether we should shut down interstates or not

- Finished up with emergency response to Hurricane Helene
- New DOT employee to assist with Emergency Operations on the east side of the district
- No updates for Maintenance Operations

ITS Update/ITS Projects/511/TMC Updates: Jason Evans

- We are working on DMS retrofit, replacing the inside of DMS and installing new colored panels over the next several weeks
- 10 DMS retrofits in the area
- Replacement for RWIS including bridge windspeed sensors
- 511 had a large increase in traffic causing it to bog down last hurricane season, the contractor has extra servers that will be in use for the upcoming Hurricane Season to prevent the lag

Performance Measures: Lacey Collins

- Lacey Collins provided the Team with the Performance Measures from February 2025 through April 2025 for the First Coast area

Incident Review: Lacey Collins/Team

- Event #8 was highlighted for further discussion:
 - 03/21/2025, Emergency Plane landing, SR-2 west of CR-127, Baker County. A small plane was traveling north when the engine failed and traffic control lost all contact. The pilot completed an emergency landing on SR-2. SR-2 was shut down for 1.5 hours.
- Event #19 was highlighted for further discussion:
 - 04/04/2025, Crash, I-95 SB at MM330, St. Johns County. A sedan collided with a charter bus resulting in a fatality. The incident lasted over 3 hours.

Maintenance Incident Review: Jimmy Maly

- Two events were highlighted for further discussion, including:
 - Event #31, 04/16/2025, Vehicle Crash, I-95 SB at SR-206, St. Johns County. A suv lost control and collided with a semi-truck causing a large fuel spill. Environmental cleanup crew responded for the large fuel spill. The incident lasted over 4.5 hours.
 - Event #38, 04/20/2025, Crash, I-295 SB at MM42, St. Duval County. A motorcycle rear ended a vehicle at a high rate of speed resulting in a fatal collision. The sedan collided with the guard rail causing significant damage. All lanes were blocked for approximately 5.25 hours.

RISC Debrief: Lacey Collins

- 03/31/2025, I-10 WB at MM342, Duval County
 - Sedan collided with a disabled semi on the outside shoulder resulting in a large debris field of vehicle parts, Walts Wrecker responded for RISC, all lanes were blocked.
- 04/14/2025, I-95 NB at MM374, Nassau County
 - Semi-truck collided with another semi-truck causing one semi's cab to become detached from the frame, Walts Wrecker responded for RISC, all lanes were blocked
