Introductions and TIM Updates

- Lacey Collins opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- First Coast TIM Team introduced themselves.
- Lacey Collins stated the purpose of the meeting is to partner together to reduce incident scene clearance times, deter congestion, and improve safety for everyone on the roadway.
- May 2025 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

TIM Discussion: Lacey Collins

- Struck By Incident statistics for 2024 and 2025
- NHTSA Speed Campaign 2025
 - Speed Related crashes statistics
- August NHTSA Safety Campaign
 - 8/1-8/30 Child Safety Awareness Month
 - 8/1-8/30 Back to School Month
 - 8/3-8/9 National Stop on Red Week
 - 8/13-9/1 Pre Labor Day Impaired Driving Enforcement
- Hurricane season is on going
 - There is a disturbance in the Atlantic with 40% chance of formation
- FDOT Safe Charge: Duval County Only
 - Free Service to motorist
 - Will only respond for dead battery
 - Limited to 15 minutes of charge
 - Must request through RTMC
 - Must meet one of the following:
 - Blocking a lane of travel
 - On a bridge
 - Unsafe location

Construction Project Update:

- I-95 widening project has begun, no finish date at this time
- I-10 widening project is almost complete, lane shifts are progressing
- I-10 and Normandy Blvd is complete
- I-95 Duval/Nassau County line is underway
- I-10 resurfacing on the west is on going
- I-95 and I-295 interchange should be completed this year

Emergency/Maintenance Operations Update: Lola Butler

- Introduced Sarah Hipps
- Coordination with FHP for protest at Camp Blanding on July 19th
- Monitoring potential disturbances off the coast

ITS Update/ITS Projects/511/TMC Updates: Jason Evans

- DMS retrofit update:
 - Completed: I-295SB at Wilson Blvd, I-295SB at Collins Rd, I-295NB north of Collins Rd
 - Upcoming: I-295 NB at Wilson Blvd, I-95NB at MM333
- WWD devices are still being installed across the First Coast Area
 - New vendors for devices
- FL511 will add additional servers if a Hurricane is expected to impact District 2
 - Last year FL511 lagged due to the number of users on the server
 - Make sure app is up to date
- RTMC is prepared and ready if a Hurricane makes landfall
- Lacey Collins advised TIM Team we can move cameras if needed for incidents upon request

Performance Measures: Lacey Collins

- Lacey Collins provided the Team with the Performance Measures from May 2025 through June 2025 for the First Coast area

Incident Review: Lacey Collins/Team

- Event #10 was highlighted for further discussion:
 - 05/09/2025, Crash, Log truck collided with pedestrian, SR-200 WB at Tributary Dr, Nassau County. A log truck was traveling west when the truck collided with a pedestrian standing in the outside lane of travel. SR-200 WB was shut down for 5.25 hours.
- Event #37 was highlighted for further discussion:
 - 06/13/2025, Crash, I-95 NB at Airport Rd, Duval County. A semi-truck hauling multiple cars caught fire when traveling north of I-95. A car hauler along with cars became fully engulfed. The incident lasted approximately 4.5 hours.

Maintenance Incident Review: Jimmy Maly

- Two events were highlighted for further discussion, including:
 - Event #6, 05/05/2025, Vehicle Crash, I-295 NB at MM53, Duval County. Two vehicles collided resulting in fatality. The incident lasted approximately 4 hours.
 - Event #33, 06/11/2025, Crash, I-295 NB at Alta Dr. Duval County. A vehicle was fleeing FHP and lost control resulting in a collision with a tree. The

driver was pronounced fatal on scene. The incident lasted approximately 8 hours.

Incident List Debrief: Lacey Collins/Team

- Handout of list provided to Team
- 48 Total events from May 1 through June 31
- 35 Events over 90-minute goal

RISC Debrief: Lacey Collins

- 06/02/2025, I-10 WB at McDuff Ave, Duval County
 - A single vehicle crash involving a trailer loaded with lumber. There was a large amount of debris on the roadway due to the lumber coming off the trailer. Minor diesel spill on scene. Allens towing responded for RISC, all lanes blocked for 5 hours and 17 minutes.
- 07/09/2025, I-95 SB at MM370, Nassau County
 - A truck hauling a 5th wheel RV traveled off the roadway down an embankment into a construction zone under the bridge. The truck and 5th wheel overturned resulting in a large debris field in the construction zone. Allens towing responded for RISC, all lanes blocked for 21 minutes, the right lane was blocked for 10 hours and 11 minutes.

 - Fire Chief will be holding training classes in Brunswick in the future in regards to refrigerated unit truck fires
 - Fire Chief will travel to provide training to agencies across the state upon request
