Meeting Minutes

Introductions and TIM Updates

- Lacey Collins opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- First Coast TIM Team introduced themselves.
- Collins stated the purpose of the meeting is to partner together to reduce incident scene clearance times, deter congestion, and improve safety for everyone on the roadway.
- May 2026 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

TIM Discussion: Lacey Collins

- Struck By Incident statistics for 2025 and 2026
 - Since our last TIM meeting 6 law enforcement officers, 1 tow operators, and 2 DOT/Safety service patrol was struck and killed
- Most recent struck by fatality occurred on July 12, 2026
 - I-75 in Pasco County FL, road ranger was on scene placing MOT when a secondary road ranger responded to assist
 - Second road ranger that responded had his lights and sign board activated
 - Second road ranger was struck in the rear by an Acura SUV
 - Acura then collided with the primary road ranger that was placing MOT resulting in a fatality
 - Driver of the Acura was placed under arrest with a BAC of 0.334
- Recap of July 4th firework event in downtown Jacksonville
 - Motorists were stopping/parking on the Fuller Warren bridge to view fireworks
 - TIM team discussed how we can prevent this from occurring in the future?
 - Barrels, LEO, sign boards, etc.
- August NHTSA Safety Campaign
 - 8/1-8/30: Child Safety Awareness month
 - 8/1-8/30: Back to School month
 - 8/2-8/8: National Stop on Red week
- Reminder: Hurricane season began June 1
- Collins provided the TIM team with Rapid Incident Scene Clearance (RISC) overview
 - RISC is a safe, quick clearance of large-scale incidents that have significant impacts on interstates/state roadways and/or will require a complex recovery effort
 - Collins is available 24/7 for on-scene questions, concerns, or issues

Construction Project Update: Bert Watson/Jacob Pickering

- I-10 widening and I-95 widening are still going on
- I-10 widening is on track for completion by end of the year or beginning of next year, weather depending
- I-10 widening on the westbound is completely opened up
- I-95 widening between Emerson and Atlantic is still on going, completion is set for second half of 2028
- I-95 widening between Emerson to JTB will start later this year
- Sr-23 has opened from Shands Bridge to US-90
- SR-211 in Riverside and Avondale is almost complete

- Monitoring tropics

ITS Update/ITS Projects/511/TMC Updates: Jason Evans

- DMS retrofits will begin again in August, removing old panels to color DMS with more pixels
 - I-295 at San Jose and I-295 north of US-17 will be the next two to be complete
- Finished wind sensor replacement project
- Lane closure tonight in the northbound Express Lane to repair 1.9 toll DMS
- No 511 updates
- TMC watching tropics
- James Maly asked if ActiveVision can detect pedestrians in construction areas
 - Evans advised that it is currently being trained to detect pedestrians but only on the roadway and shoulders

Performance Measures: Lacey Collins

- Lacey Collins provided the Team with the Performance Measures from May 2026 through June 2026 for the First Coast area

Incident Review: Lacey Collins/Team

- Event #12 was highlighted for further discussion:
 - 05/17/2026, Crash, SR-200 at Sadler Rd, Nassau County. Sedan traveled off the roadway and collided with a tree, sedan became fully engulfed, driver was pronounced deceased. The incident lasted approximately 9.75 hours.

- Event #24 was highlighted for further discussion:
 - 05/28/2026, Crash, SR-202 EB at Marsh Landing Pkwy, Duval County. Pickup truck was traveling westbound in the eastbound lanes on SR-202 and collided with a SUV head on, driver and passenger of the SUV were pronounced deceased. The incident lasted approximately 6 hours.

Maintenance Incident Review: James Maly

- Two events were highlighted for further discussion, including:
 - Event #33, 06/11/2026, Fatality Crash, I-10 WB at I-295, Duval County. Driver was traveling WB at collided with a guardrail, driver was pronounced deceased on scene. The incident lasted approximately 2.5 hours.
 - Event #35, 06/12/2026, Fatality Crash, I-295 NB before Philips Hwy, Duval County. Pedestrian was sitting on a guard rail and then walked into the roadway, pedestrian was struck by a vehicle and pronounced deceased on scene. The incident lasted approximately 4.25 hours.

Incident List Debrief: Lacey Collins/Team

- Handout of list provided to Team
- 47 Total events from May 1 through June 31
- 36 Events over 90-minute goal

RISC Debrief: Lacey Collins

- 05/01/2026, I-95 NB at MM331, St. Johns County
 - Disabled vehicle blocking a lane of travel was struck by another vehicle, semi-truck and trailer struck the secondary vehicle and crossed all lanes of travel coming to final rest blocking the roadway. Large fuel spill. Allen's Towing responded for RISC, road blockage for 5 hours and 32 minutes.
- 06/11/2026, I-95 SB at MM310, St. Johns County
 - Semi-truck and trailer collided with the median guardrail. Semi-truck and trailer overturned and became fully engulfed. Driver was later pronounced deceased. John's Towing responded for RISC, road blockage for 6 hours and 28 minutes.

Open Forum: Team

- Webber advised wires are being stolen and request all TIM partners keep an eye out
 - Wonderwood bridge has had wire stolen 3 times now and creating asset damage as well
