Introductions and TIM Updates

- Lacey Collins opened the meeting and welcomed everyone.
- First Coast TIM Team introduced themselves.
- Lacey Collins stated the purpose of the meeting is to partner together to reduce incident scene clearance times, deter congestion, and improve safety for everyone on the roadway.
- March 2026 First Coast TIM Team Meeting Minutes were sent to the Team previously, and receiving no comments, they stand as approved.

TIM Discussion: Lacey Collins

- Struck By Incident statistics for 2025 and 2026
 - Since our last TIM meeting 3 law enforcement officers, 2 tow operators, and one service tech was struck and killed
- May is Motorcycle Safety Awareness month
 - The observance was founded in the 1980's by the Motorcycle Riders Foundation
 - National Safety Council later adopted and promoted the event
 - The campaign has become a key opportunity to educate the public about motorcycle safety and reduce fatalities
 - Safety Tips:
 - Be aware of motorcycles
 - Wear appropriate safety gear
 - Obey traffic rules
 - Perform safety checks
- Memorial Day is May 25, 2026
 - Upcoming Events in the First Coast Area:
 - Jacksonville Jazz Festival May 21-24
 - Memorial Day River Fest in Clay County May 25
- Hurricane Season begins June 1st through November 30th
 - ESU Corridors:
 - I-10: WB from US-301 in Jacksonville to US-319 in Tallahassee
 - I-95: NB from SR-706 in Jupiter to SR-9B in Jacksonville
 - RTMC will monitor traffic volumes, traffic conditions, and speed during the Hurricanes
 - FDOT, FTE, and Asset Maintenance Contractors will ensure ESU routes are clear
 - Road ranger patrols will increase

- Construction companies will be required to secure work zones and may be required to open lanes that were previously permitted for closure
- TIM team will be available 24/7 at the RTMC to coordinate with outside agencies
- Department of Environmental Protection
 - Report on Petroleum based spills:
 - Spills greater than 25 gallons
 - Spills into or involving state water ways
 - Spills requiring any state/federal notifications
 - Abandoned drums
 - Report on Chemical based spills:
 - SARA/EHS/CERCLA releases
 - All spills threatening population or the environment
 - All spills requiring evacuation

Construction Project Update: Bert Watson

- I-95 and I-295 north interchange should be completed within the next month
- I-10 widening on the westbound side is in final configuration
- I-10 widening on the eastbound side is close to being completed
- I-95 widening near Emerson widening is still on going, in the winter, Emerson to Baymeadows will begin
- Sr-23 at Shands Bridge is progressing
- I-95 Bridge at in Nassau should be done within the next month
- No work will be completed on Buckman Bridge until June and then slowly progress

Emergency Operations Update: Sarah Hipps/Lola Butler

- Hurricane season is approaching
- Reviewing plans

Maintenance Operations Update: Carrie Stanbridge/Sarah Hipps

- Working on joints on the Acosta Bridge
- Daytime lane closures on Mathews Bridge due to maintenance

ITS Update/ITS Projects/511/TMC Updates: Jose Morales/Jason Evans

- Jose advised ITS maintenance contractors are focusing on preventive maintenance and routine maintenance at this time
- Jose advised DMS Retrofits on I-75 and I-10 will be spread out over the next 2-3 years
- Jose advised Wind sensors, water sensors, and fog sensors are reaching end of life and we are testing new sensors
- Jason advised no update from 511
- Activision is fully deployed across District 2

- Training Activision to detect congestion and pedestrians on the interstate

- Lacey Collins provided the Team with the Performance Measures from March 2026 through April 2026 for the First Coast area

Incident Review: Lacey Collins/Team

- Event #2 was highlighted for further discussion:
 - 03/01/2026, Crash, SR-10 and Brookside Circle W, Duval County. Teen was traveling westbound when he crossed over the median into oncoming traffic and collided with multiple vehicles. Three fatalities were confirmed. The incident lasted approximately 6.5 hours.
- Event #35 was highlighted for further discussion:
 - 04/02/2026, Crash, I-95 SB near SR-9B, Duval County. Five vehicle collision with injuries reported. The incident lasted approximately 8.25 hours.

Maintenance Incident Review: Jimmy Maly

- Two events were highlighted for further discussion, including:
 - Event #44, 04/17/2026, Fatality Crash, I-295 NB at Pulaski, Duval County. Motorcycle collided with semi-truck and trailer resulting in fatality. The incident lasted approximately 4 hours.
 - Event #55, 04/29/2026, Police Activity, I-95NB/SB at MM321, St. Johns County. Suicidal driver barricaded himself in the vehicle and later committed suicide. The incident lasted approximately 2.25 hours.

RISC Debrief: Lacey Collins

- 04/27/2026, I-10 EB at MM354, Duval County
 - A wrong way driver collision resulting in fatality. Large debris field across all lanes. Allen's Towing responded for RISC, all lanes were blocked for 5 hours and 35 minutes.
