- Scotty welcomed everyone to the meeting
- Scotty advised this weekend, if there is any ice on the roadways, be sure to notify TMC so maintenance can be notified
- Scotty had new employees introduce themselves
- Scotty went over things to do before leaving the yard
 - Make sure trucks are clean
 - Check to make sure everything on truck is operational and fluids are good
 - Inspection sheets are to be done before leaving the yard
 - Make sure all tools are there and secured
 - If you have issues with the truck, let Scotty or Sam know so a certified mechanic can fix the problem
- Scotty discussed how to properly fill out the inspection sheets with the road rangers
- Scotty went over the fire extinguishers and how to properly read the dates
 - o If you use the fire extinguishers, make sure you write it on the board, so it's noted
 - Do not use fire extinguishers on fully engulfed vehicles, semi brake fires, or large brush fires. They will not be able to put the fire out.
- Scotty discussed flare usage on the trucks
- Scotty went over things to do while driving
 - Drive in the right lane, 5MPH below the posted speed limit
 - If you must pass someone, accelerate, pass them, and get back in the right lane
 - Look 3 times before changing lanes
 - Keep your distance from the vehicle in front of you
 - When merging into traffic, look 3 times and make sure you have plenty of space
 - Stop safely if you need to change lanes for an event
 - Do not use official turn arounds
 - Do not be on your phone while driving
- Scotty advised the road rangers of general safety on an event
 - First person on scene is always in charge

- If law enforcement tells you to not put cones out, tell dispatch and tell the officer if you cannot set up the cones, then you cannot stay on scene
- Call all stops into TMC and put sign boards up
- Stay in contact with TMC
 - If you do not hear radio communications for a while, check in
- Be sure to get vehicle information
- Deploy all cones on all events
- We do have hats
 - You can wear a beanie, just make sure it is appropriate
- Scotty discussed F.S. 316.003
 - o If you need to use the E-Lane, do not go over 5MPH
- Scotty advised no procedural errors for the month
- Scotty went over break times and shift change times
 - 15-minute break limits
 - o Do not take breaks during peak times unless it's an emergency
 - Leave the yard by 6:45am
 - Limit shift changes to 15 minutes
 - O Do not call off shift before your shift is over
- Scotty discussed MOT notes
 - All cones get placed out no matter what
 - Always be aware of your surroundings
 - Do not put your back to traffic
 - o Always assume other drivers will not see you
 - Put a barrier between yourself and on coming vehicles
 - O Do not sit in your truck on an event
 - o Point your tires towards the safest place if your vehicle were to be hit
 - Do not trust anyone but yourself

- Scotty went over good and bad MOT pictures
- Scotty advised road rangers, when giving fuel, be sure to make sure the vehicle is out of gas
 - Call the tag into TMC for approval
- Scotty reminded road rangers 24/7 routes do not get overtime codes
- Scotty reminded road rangers to only put factual information over the radio
- Scotty advised do not accept tips from anyone
- Scotty reminded road rangers to not put anything on social media
 - Do not take pictures of an event unless asked to do so by dispatch
 - Only send pictures on work phone
 - o Do not put First Coast Road Ranger as your employment on social media
- Scotty advised the road rangers that the company cell phones are to be used for communications with TMC and FCRR only
 - Motorist are allowed to use cell phones
 - Do not use to send text messages
 - O Do not use to stream videos
 - Do not turn on Hotspot
 - Text and data are being monitored, any personal usage will be charged back to the employee
- Scotty discussed road rangers speeding in trucks
 - Do not speed in the trucks
 - Speed is monitored
- Scotty discussed chain of command and duties
 - Scott Christmas Manager
 - Jackie Hall HR
 - Use chain of command if there are any issues
