- Scotty opened meeting having new Road Rangers introduce themselves
- Scotty discussed MOT from a crash on 11/21
 - The truck should be parked in the road until road ranger is able to get cones out
 - O Truck is a barrier between traffic and the road ranger
- Scotty discussed things to do while driving
 - Drive in right lane 5 mph below the posted speed limit
 - Look 3 times before changing lanes
 - o Keep your distance from the vehicle in front of you
 - o Merging into traffic, look 3 times and give plenty of time to get up to speed
 - O Go to next exit turn around and come back
 - Do not use E-Lanes
- Scotty advised do not use official turn arounds
- Scotty advised pull off the road to use your cell phone or make changes on your events
- Scotty advised try to be proactive
 - If on the way to a route and you come up on an accident, stop for the accident even if it is not on your route
- Next meeting is December 21st, 2022
- Scotty advised on fuel events, be sure to get the tag and get fuel approval before giving gas
- Scotty advised 24/7 routes do not get over time codes
- Scotty advised double check hygiene and uniforms
 - Everyone's hygiene is good
 - Do not leave food in trucks
- Scotty reminded road rangers to never take pictures of an event unless TMC asks for the picture
 - Only send the picture to dispatch
 - Do not post on social media
 - Gave an example of fire rescue posting a picture of a fatal crash and that's how relatives found out about the crash
- Scotty reminded road rangers to not talk about other vendors and do not confront them
 - If there are any issues, call Scotty and he will take care of it
 - Do not argue with other vendors
- Scotty advised only use E-Lanes for emergency situations only

- Drive less than 5mph
- Only use for major situations like all lane blocked events
- Scotty went over procedural errors
 - Only one for the month
- Scotty reminded road rangers that you are not allowed to take breaks during peak times
 - 6am-9am
 - o 3pm-7pm
 - If an emergency, tell dispatch
 - o If you are on a 12-hour shift, you have a little bit of flexibility on 15-minute break
- Scotty discussed flagged break times
- Scotty discussed flagged shift change times
 - o Make sure you are inspecting the trucks before leaving the yard
 - O Make sure all tools are on the truck
 - If you have a flat tire, etc. tell dispatch so you can be put in service while you fix it
- Scotty reminded road rangers to not call off shift before shift is over
 - If there is an emergency, call Scotty and he will get you relived
- Scotty went over MOT pictures
- Scotty discussed importance of MOT
 - O All 15 cones get placed out on all events
 - Never turn your back to traffic
 - Always assume other drivers won't see you
 - Never sit in your vehicle while at an event
 - Do not get in a hurry
- Scotty asked if there are any issues with vendors?
- Scotty advised you must have red tags in the trucks
- Scotty went over hurricanes and make sure you are still prepared as hurricane season is not over
- Scotty went over the safety and chain of command while
 - No phones while driving
 - All cones out
 - Whoever is first on scene is in charge of the event
 - Call all events into TMC

- Scotty advised make sure all trucks are clean
 - Check all tools
 - Secure toolboxes if possible
 - o Be aware when stopping at gas stations and watch your trucks
- Scotty discussed insurance for road rangers
 - o Company will be calling soon for verification
 - o Company calls 45 days into employment as insurance kicks in 60 days after employment
- Scotty discussed FCRR cell phone usage
 - O Do not use cell phone for personal usage
- Scotty concluded meeting
