FDOT/ 1st Coast Road Rangers

- Chris started meeting by introducing new employees
- Chris advised road rangers of things to do before leaving the yard daily
 - $\circ~$ Clean trucks inside and out
 - Check that everything is operational, and fluids are full
 - Make sure all tools are on the truck
 - o Take Inventory before leaving the yard, once you leave, truck and tools are your responsibility
 - Always make sure you are in proper dress code
- Chris discussed things to do while driving
 - **o** Drive in the right lane, 5 mph below the speed limit
 - Look 3 times before changing lanes
 - $\circ~$ Keep proper and safe distance from the vehicle in front of you
 - Look 3 times when merging into traffic
 - If you pass an event, go to next exit to turn around and come back
 - Do not use official turn arounds
 - Do not use your phone while driving
 - Chris went over general safety with road rangers
 - First person on scene at an event is in charge
 - Do not use cell phones while driving
 - $\circ~$ Call all stops into TMC and put sign boards up
 - $\circ~$ Stay in communication with TMC ~
 - Always get vehicle information on an event
 - \circ Place all 15 cones out
- Chris showed pictures of accidents involving road rangers
- Chris advised there were no procedural errors for the month
- Chris reminded road ranger of breaks and shift change times
 - Breaks are 15 minutes
 - $\circ~$ Do not take breaks between 6am and 9am or 3pm to 7pm
 - Limit shift changes to 15 minutes
 - $\circ~$ Do not call off shift before shift is over
- Chris advised road rangers how to properly complete MOT
 - All 15 cones get placed out
 - **o** Always be aware of your surroundings
 - Never sit in your vehicle on an event
 - $\circ~$ Do not turn your back to traffic
 - Use your vehicle as a barrier
- Chris showed good/bad MOT pictures
- Chris advised road rangers to make sure vehicles are out of fuel before giving gas
- Chris reminded road rangers that 24/7 routes do not get over time codes
- Chris reminded road rangers to turn safe tow codes into the office
- Chris advised to only give factual information over the radio
- Chris told road rangers to not accept any form of tips from citizens
- Chris advised to stay off social media and never post pictures or information from events
- Chris reminded all road rangers that cell phones are for business purposes only

 Citizens can use company phone if need be
- Chris went over where to go for help for road rangers
- Chris asked if there has been any issues with other vendors
- Chris discussed new light bars being installed on the trucks
- Chris concluded meeting
