- Scotty opened meeting by introducing new employees
- Scotty went over topics to be covered this meeting
- Scotty went over things to do before leaving the yard for shift
 - Make sure trucks are cleaned inside and out
 - Check truck for all tools
 - Make sure all fluids on the truck are full and check tires
- Scotty advised road rangers of F.S. 316.003 which classifies road rangers as emergency vehicles
 - However, do not use the official use turn arounds
- Scotty reminded road rangers of things to do while driving
 - Drive in the right lane, 5mph below the posted speed limit
 - Look 3 times before merging into traffic
 - Keep your distance from the vehicle in front of you
 - Do not use your phone while driving
- Scotty went over things to do while on an event
 - Stop safetly at an event, do not slam on brakes or cut across traffic. Go to next exit to turn around and come back
 - Place out all 15 cones
 - Whoever is on scene first at an event is the one in charge
 - All stops get called into TMC and put your sign board up
 - Stay in communication with TMC throughout the event
- Scotty discussed procedural errors for the month
- Scotty advised road rangers you must wear your seat belt at all times
- Scotty advised road rangers to not follow vehicles
 - Get the vehicle information and give to TMC
- Scotty showed diagram of how to correctly park on an event
- Scotty went over break and shift change notes
 - Limit breaks and shift changes to 15 minutes

- Do not take a break during peak times unless an emergency
- Peak times are 6a-9a and 3p-7p
- Scotty went over MOT notes
 - All 15 cones get placed out on all events
 - Never turn your back to traffic
 - Always assume other drivers can not see you
 - o Try to put a barrier between yourself and on coming traffic
 - o Never trust anyone but yourself
 - Do not get in a hurry
- Scotty showed correct and incorrect MOT pictures
- Scotty reminded road rangers always get fuel approval from TMC before giving gas
 - Give TMC the tag on the vehicle
- Scotty advised road rangers that 24/7 routes do not get over time codes
- Scotty reminded road rangers to be short and factual on the radio
- Scotty advised do not post anything on social media or accepts tips of any form from motorists
- Scotty went over new cell phones that are being given to road rangers
- Scotty advised road rangers of where to go for help
- Scotty went over notes from HR
 - Check timesheet hours weekly
 - If there is an issue with your timesheet, report it to your supervisor
 - If you get hurt on the job, notify a supervisor immediately. If you go to the doctor for your injuries, you must get a clearence note to return to work
- Scotty asked if there have been issues with any vendors
- Scotty concluded meeting
