FDOT/ 1st Coast Road Rangers

- Scotty began meeting by introducing new employees
- Scotty went over the topics to be covered during this meeting
- Scotty went over things the road rangers should do before leaving the yard
 - Clean and wash the trucks inside and out
 - o Check operations of fluids and supplies each shift
 - Check that all tools are present
 - Double check hygeine and uniform
- Scotty explained F.S. 316.003 classifying road rangers as emergency vehicles
- Scotty discussed things to do while driving
 - o Drive in the right lane 5 mph below posted speed limit
 - Look 3 times before changing lanes
 - Keep distance from vehicles in front of you
 - No texting while driving
- Scotty went over things to do while at an event
 - o Do not stop quickly to get to an event, use next exit to turn around and come back
 - Do not use official turn arounds; you are responsible for any accidents that occur
 - o Pull off the road to read messages
 - Follow chain of command at the event
 - Call TMC for all stops
 - o Put sign boards up and deploy all 15 cones
 - Do not use anything but issued cones for MOT. Do not use construction barrels for MOT
- Scotty advised road rangers you are on route for duration for your shift
 - o Do not come off of your route before your shift is over
 - Do not stage or park waiting for an event
- Scotty advised there were no procedural errors for the month
- Scotty discussed general safety notes
 - Must wear your seatbelt

- Do not follow motorist unless requested by TMC
 - Amber Alert, Silver Alert etc
 - Do not break any laws to follow motorist
- Scotty reminded road rangers we are in hurricane season
 - o June 1st through November 30th
 - o Remember to have a plan in place for your family and be prepared
- Scotty discussed breaks and shift changes
 - o Breaks limit to 15 minutes
 - o Do not take breaks during peak traffic times unless an emergency
 - 6am-9am and 3pm-7pm
 - o Get off the yard by 6:15. Limit to 15 minutes on the yard
 - Discussed flagged breaks and shift changes
- Scotty went over general MOT notes
 - o All 15 cones get placed out
 - Sign boards up and call TMC
 - o Maintain situational awareness, never turn your back to traffic
 - Always assume other drivers won't see you
 - o Put a barrier between yourself and on coming vehicles
 - Always assume someone will hit your truck
 - Do not sit in your truck on an event
 - Point your tires in a direction as if your vehicle will be pushed
 - Never trust anyone but yourself
 - Do not get in a hurry
 - Showed MOT pictures
- Scotty discussed general notes with road rangers
 - Get approval from TMC before giving fuel
 - o 24/7 routes do not get overtime codes

- o Keep things factual on the radio
- o Do not take tips under any circustance
- o Do not post anything on social media
- Scotty reminded road ranger do not use cell phones for personal use
 - o Do not send or receive personal text messages
 - o Do not turn on hotspots
 - o Do not stream videos or music
 - o New phones will be distributed soon
- Scotty advised where to go for help
- Scotty asked if there have been any issues with other vendors
- Scotty concluded meeting
