- Scotty began meeting by welcoming everyone
- Scotty introduced new employees
- Scotty went over the topics to be covered
- Scotty discussed things to do before leaving the yard
 - Clean trucks inside and out
 - Check operation of horn and fluids
 - Make sure all tools are there and secured
 - Take inventory before leaving the yard
 - Check hygeine and uniform
- Scotty went over F.S. 316.003 authorizing road rangers as emergency vehicle
- Scotty discussed general safety while driving
 - o Drive in the right lane 5mph below posted speed limit
 - Look 3 times before merging into traffic
 - o Keep proper distance from the vehicle in front of you
 - No cell phone usage while driving
- Scotty discussed general safety while at an event
 - o Do not speed to an event
 - o If you pass an event, go to next exit to turn around
 - Do not use official turn arounds
 - o Follow chain of command at an event
 - All stops call TMC and put sign boards up
 - Stay in communication with TMC
 - Get all vehicle information
 - All 24 cones get placed out
- Scotty advised road rangers are on route for their whole shift
 - Do not park
 - Do not stage

- Do not come off route early
- No procedural errors for the month
- Scotty reminded road rangers to always wear your seatbelt
- Scotty advised do not follow a vehicle unless requested by TMC
- Scotty discussed some general safety notes
 - o When being over taken by another vehicle, slow down and let them pass
 - Watch for turn signals of vehicles getting over in front of you
- Scotty advised we are at the end of hurricane season
- Scotty went over break and shift change notes
 - Limit breaks to 15 minutes
 - Do not take breaks during peak traffic times
 - 6am-9am and 3pm-7pm
 - o Do not take breaks at the end of your shift
 - Limit shift changes to 15 minutes on the yard
- Scotty went over MOT notes
 - All 24 cones get placed out
 - Always maintain situational awareness
 - Never turn your back to traffic
 - Always assume drivers won't see you
 - Put a barrier between yourself and on coming traffic
 - Always assume someone will hit your truck
 - Point tires in safest direction if your vehicle were to be hit and pushed
- Scotty showed MOT pictures
- Scotty advised some general notes
 - Create an event and give tag to TMC before giving out fuel
 - 24/7 routes do not get overtime codes
 - o Be short and factual on the radio

- Do not accept any tips from motorists
- o Do not recommend service centers to motorists
- o Do not post pictures of events on social media
- Scotty reminded road rangers that company cell phones are for work use only
 - o Motorists can use cell phones to make a phone call
 - o Do not send or receive personal text messages
 - o Do not stream video or music
 - o Do not turn on hot spot
- Scotty advised where to go for help
- Scotty went over some HR notes
 - o We are noting break and shift change time problems
 - Policy updates are coming in January
- Scotty reminded road rangers of general notes
 - o Keep trucks clean
 - o Make sure shirts are buttoned up and hats are facing forward
 - o Always be professional no matter the situation
