- Scotty began the meeting by welcoming everyone
- Scotty went over the topics to be covered
  - General safety
  - Procedural Errors
  - Breaks and shift change
  - o MOT
  - o Radio etiquette and time on the radio
  - o Cell phone usage
  - HR notes
- Scotty discussed things to do before leaving the yard
  - Clean trucks inside and out
  - Check operation and all fluids and supplies for the shift
  - Make sure tools are present and secured
  - Take inventory on the truck
  - Double check hygiene and uniform
- Scotty advised things to do while driving
  - Drive in the right lane 5 mph below posted speed limit
  - o Look 3 times when changing lanes and merging into traffic
  - Keep proper distance from the vehicle in front of you (3 car lengths)
  - No texting while driving
- Scotty reminded road rangers to always wear your seatbelt
  - Worker's comp may not cover an accident if you are not wearing your seat belt
  - This is Florida law
- Scotty reminded road rangers to not follow motorists unless asked to do so by TMC
- Scotty advised no matter what the law allows you to do, do not make U-turns
- Scotty advised when you are being passed by a vehicle, slow down and let them pass
- Scotty discussed the general safety while on an event

- o Do not speed to an event or cut across all lanes to stop for an event
- Do not use official turn arounds
- Pull off the road to read messages or type in an event
- Follow chain of command at an event
- All stops, call TMC and put sign boards up
- o Stay in communication with TMC throughout the event
- Get all vehicle information
- All 24 cones must be deployed
- Scotty went over F.S. 316.003 authorizing road rangers as emergency vehicle
- Scotty advised no procedural errors for the month
- Scotty reminded road rangers of break and shift change notes
  - Limit breaks to 15 minutes
  - Do not take breaks during peak traffic times (6a-9a and 3p-7p)
  - Get off the yard by 6:15am and limit shift changes to 15 minutes
  - You are not allowed to call off shift before your shift is over
- Scotty went over MOT notes
  - All 24 cones get placed out
  - Maintain situational awareness
  - Never turn your back to traffic
  - Assume other drivers can't or won't see you
  - Put a barrier between yourself and on coming traffic
  - Always assume someone will hit your truck
  - Never trust anyone but yourself
  - Do not get in a hurry
- Scotty reminded road rangers of the following
  - Get approval from TMC before giving fuel
  - 24/7 routes do not get overtime codes

- Be short and factual on the radio
- $\circ$   $\;$  Do not accept any form of tip or compensation
- o Do not recommend motorists any services
- $\circ$   $\,$  Do not take pictures of an event unless requested by TMC  $\,$
- Do not post employment on social media
- Scotty went over where to go for help
- Scotty asked if there have been any issues with other vendors
- Scotty concluded meeting
