- Marshall welcomed everyone
- Marshall had new employees introduce themselves
- Next meeting August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022
- Marshall discussed safety and importance of putting out cones
  - Every single event needs cones
  - Look 3 times then turn your head and look
  - Keep proper distance
  - Drive 5 MPH under posted speed limit
  - Do not use official turn arounds
    - Showed pics of a Road Ranger crash when using official turn around
- Marshall advised if you need to use your phone, pull off the road
- Marshall advised do not make sudden lane changes to get to an event
  - If you pass an event, go to next exit, turn around and come back to it
- Marshall advised to call in to TMC to get approval code before giving gas
  - If blocking, advise TMC to rush on the fuel code
    - Dee Dee also advised, vehicle blocking will not be disapproved for fuel
    - Still need a fuel code
- Get SafeTow Codes from TMC for SafeTows
- Marshall advised Road Rangers are doing good with hygiene and dress code
- Marshall went over Chain of Command
- Marshall advised do not take pictures of scene and put on social media. Stay off social media when on an event
  - Only takes pictures when asked by TMC and send on Zello
  - Also, warned Road Rangers about what information is said on scene as the Media Devices can pick up on it and report it on the news
  - Road Rangers are not to say when someone is impaired
- Marshall went over Procedural Errors
  - Not communicating with TMC

- Check phone to make sure you have no missed calls from dispatch or supervisor
    - Check in with TMC every 10 minutes when on an event
  - Not deploying cones – when stopped out with an event, must deploy cones. No exceptions
    - Road Rangers will start being fined
    - 1<sup>st</sup> occurrence \$25
    - 2<sup>nd</sup> occurrence \$75
    - Last occurrence will be termination
  - Road Ranger Truck needs to be parked behind the vehicle it is servicing
- Marshall went over shift changes/break times
  - Make sure you are checking breaks on SPARR App
  - Shift changes need to be done in 15 minutes
  - Need to be On Route by 6:30am
  - Stay On Route until 6:30pm
- Marshall went over MOT
  - Cones need to be placed leaving no gaps for vehicles
  - Cones need to be placed as far back from event as possible
  - Went over split cones for center lane blockages
  - Call for back up when moving vehicles to the opposite sides of the roadway
- Marshall advised Road Rangers to stay hydrated and take their time on scene. Do not overheat
- Marshall advised Road Rangers will be held accountable for their cleanliness of themselves and trucks, Procedural Errors, No Shows and Call Outs, Rule Violations, Shift Changes and Break Times.
  - Road Rangers will be fined for safety violations
- Marshall went over Pay Raises, effective yesterday 7/11/2022
  - Road Rangers pay is now up to \$18 a hour
- Second Ford Truck is coming in, hopefully next month. Will be all propane.
- Marshall asked about any issues with other Vendors

- Communication issues with JSO/FHP.
  - Uniforms are coming back still dirty when sent to vendor to be cleaned.
- Marshall said good job on putting Red Tags on vehicles
- Marshall reminded Road Rangers Hurricane Season is here
- Marshall advised once you leave the yard in a truck, you are responsible for everything in that truck. Make sure everything is on the truck that is supposed to be.
- Amanda went over truck inspections
  - Trucks are dirty
  - Cones missing reflective tape
  - Make sure FCRR Cones are staying with the trucks. Cones being swapped out with Jorgenson Cones
