- Marshall began meeting
- Marshall had new employees introduce themselves
- Marshall advised Hurricane Ian is done.
 - Next Hurricane, will ask for volunteers two weeks before a hurricane comes
 - Pay rate will be different than regular pay (\$30 an hour)
 - Hours and location will need to be fluid
 - Not all routes will be designated hurricane pay only the extra routes with extra time
- Marshall discussed things to do while driving
 - Stay in the right lane and travel 5 mph under speed limit
 - Look 3 times in mirrors before changing lanes
 - Do not tailgate
 - Use the next possible turn around spot, do not slam on brakes to get to an event
 - Never use official use turn arounds
 - Pull off the road to use the phone
- State Farm logos are coming off the trucks
 - Averaging 2 trucks per day
- Next meeting is November 2nd, 2022
- Marshall advised Road Rangers to make sure they are getting fuel approval codes from dispatch before giving vehicles gas
- Marshall explained 24/7 routes do not get over time codes
- Marshall advised all Safe Tow codes received from TMC need to be called into the office
- Marshall advised Road Rangers to continue doing a good job keeping uniforms clean
- Marshall reminded Road Rangers to not be on the phone on a crash scene
 - Do not post any pictures on social media
- Marshall showed pictures for a Road Ranger involved crash
- Marshall went over Procedural Errors
 - Only 3 this month
- Marshall went over Break Times
 - o Break times have improved
- Marshall discussed Shift Changes times
 - Only 1 this month
- Marshall advised no breaks between 6am-9am and 3pm-7pm
- Marshall advised leave the yard by 6:15am
- Marshall advised only take 5 minutes for shift change at the yard
- Marshall showed good MOT pictures
- Marshall advised put all 15 cones out on any event
- Do not get in a hurry
- Marshall concluded the meeting
