- Marshall started the meeting by having new employees introduce themselves
- Marshall went over things to do while driving
  - Always drive in the right lane, 5 MPH below posted speed limit
  - $\circ$   $\quad$  Look three times before changing lanes
  - $\circ$   $\quad$  Keep a good distance from the vehicle in front of you
  - $\circ$   $\quad$  Look three times when merging into traffic
  - Do not stop quickly if you miss or see an event. Go to next exit to turn around and come back
  - Do not use official turn arounds
  - Do not use your phone while driving. Pull off to a safe area
  - Next meeting is December 7<sup>th</sup>
- Marshall reminded Road Rangers to be sure to get approval from TMC before giving out fuel.
  - Do not try to give a semi diesel as we do not carry enough to get them started
  - Marshall reminded Road Rangers that 24/7 Routes do not get overtime codes
- Marshall advised to be sure to turn all safe tow codes in
- Marshall reminded Road Rangers about good hygiene
  - Everyone's uniforms have been looking good past couple of months
- Marshall advised Road Rangers to not be on cell phones at an event
  - Do not take pictures of an event
  - Do not post anything on social media
- Marshall went over the Procedural Errors and Break Times
  - Only a few procedural errors for the month
  - o Break times, be sure to watch the times you are taking a break
    - No breaks between 6am-9am and 3pm-7pm unless an emergency
- Marshall went over Shift Changes
  - Limit shift changes to 5 minutes on the yard
- Marshall reminded Road Rangers to not call off shift before the shift is over
- Marshall showed pictures of MOT good and bad
- Marshall went over MOT notes
  - All 15 cones get placed out
  - Never turn your back to traffic
  - Always be aware of surroundings
  - Try to put a barrier between yourself and traffic
  - Do not sit in your vehicle while parked at an event
  - Never trust anyone but yourself
    - Including making sure all equipment is in your vehicle
  - Marshall asked Road Ranger if there have been any issues with other vendors
- Marshall advised Road Rangers to make sure there are always Red Tags in their trucks along with comment cards
- Marshall advised Hurricane season is about over
- Marshall discussed general safety
  - First Road Ranger on scene is always in charge of the event
  - No using cell phones or texting and driving
  - All stops require sign boards and call to TMC
  - o Always stay in contact with TMC and let them know what is going on at the scene
  - Be sure to get vehicle information for every event
  - All 15 cones must be deployed
  - Marshall reminded Road Rangers that it is their responsibility to make sure the trucks are clean
    - Keep trucks washed and wiped down at the end of every shift
      - Make sure all tools are on the trucks before you leave the yard
      - Do not depend on your partner to check the truck
      - o All tools are your responsibility once you leave the yard
- Marshall discussed chain of command
  - If anyone needs anything HR related, get with Jackie
  - Be sure to answer calls from Elite reference benefits
- Marshall discussed cell phone usage and phone bill increase
  - Do not use company cell phone for personal use
- Marshall concluded the meeting
