1. FIRST COAST ROAD RANGERS PRESENTATION

- Chris started meeting by introducing new employees
- . Chris advised road rangers that after the meeting they will go over new benefits
- . Chris reminded road rangers of things to do before leaving the yard
 - Clean trucks inside and out
 - Check that everything is operational, and fluids are full
 - Make sure all tools are on the truck
 - Take Inventory before leaving the yard, once you leave, truck and tools are your responsibility
 - Always make sure you are in proper dress code
- · Chris discussed things to do while driving
 - Drive in the right lane, 5 mph below the speed limit
 - Look 3 times before changing lanes and merging into traffic
 - Keep proper distance from the vehicle in front of you
 - If you pass an event, go to next exit to turn around and come back
 - Do not use official turn arounds
 - Do not use your phone while driving
- Chris went over general safety with road rangers
 - First person on scene at an event is in charge of the event
 - . Do not use cell phones while driving
 - Call all stops into TMC and put sign boards up
 - Stay in communication with TMC
 - Always get vehicle information on an event
 - Place all 15 cones out
- Chris went over the procedural errors for the month
 - Most procedural errors are communication errors with TMC
- Chris went over road ranger breaks and shift change times for the month
 - Breaks are 15 minutes
 - Do not take breaks between 6am and 9am or 3pm to 7pm
 - Limit shift changes to 15 minutes
 - Do not call off shift before shift is over
- Chris discussed how to properly set out MOT
 - All 15 cones get placed out
 - Always be aware of your surroundings
 - Never sit in your vehicle on an event
 - Do not turn your back to traffic
 - Use your vehicle as a barrier
- Chris advised road rangers to make sure vehicles are out of fuel before giving gas
 - Check fuel gage
- Chris reminded road rangers that 24/7 routes do not get over time codes
- Chris reminded road rangers to turn safe tow codes into the office
- Chris advised to be short over the radio
- Chris told road rangers to not accept any form of tips from citizens
- Chris advised do not post negative comments on social media about First Coast Road Rangers
- Chris reminded all road rangers that cell phones are for business purposes only
 - Citizens can use company phone if needed
- Chris went over where to go for help for road rangers
 - Introduced the new benefits people
- Chris asked if there has been any issues with other vendors
 - Discussed issues with Jorgenson
- Chris concluded meeting
