5. ROAD RANGER OPERATOR QUESTIONS

- Chris began the meeting and asked if there were any new employees at the meetings
- Chris went over the topics to be discussed
- Chris discussed things to do before leaving the yard for shift
 - O Clean and wash the truck inside and out
 - Check all fluids and supplies
 - o Be sure the horn works; have had to replace a few over the last month
 - o Take inventory of tools
 - Double check hygeine and uniform
- Chris went over the F.S. for emergency vehicles
- Chris reminded road rangers of things to do while driving
 - Stay in the right lane, 5mph below posted speed limit
 - When changing lanes or mergining, look 3 times
 - o Keep distance from the vehicle in front of you
 - No texting while driving
- Chris went over things to do at an event
 - o If you pass an event, go to next available turn around and come back
 - Do not use official turn arounds
 - o Follow chain of command at an event
 - o Call TMC and put sign boards up on every event
 - o Stay in communication with TMC
 - Get vehicle information
 - Deploy all 15 cones
- Chris went over procedural errors
 - o 2 for the month
- Chris discussed breaks and shift change notes
 - Do not take breaks during peak traffic times unless an emergency
 - o Be off the yard in 15 minutes for shift changes
 - Do not call off shift until shift is over
- Chris showed a job well done email for a road ranger
- Chris went over proper MOT
 - o All 15 cones get placed out
 - Maintain situational awareness
 - Never turn your back to traffic
 - o Always assume other drivers can't or wont see you
 - o Put a barrier between yourself and on coming vehicles if possible
 - Always assume someone is going to hit your truck
 - Do not sit in your vehicle on an event
 - Point your tires in the proper direction when stopped
 - Don't trust anyone but yourself
 - Unless there is an immediate threat to safety, do not speed
- Marshall advised road rangers to not use motorists jacks to jack up a vehicle for a tire change
- Chris showed MOT pictures
 - Went over the goods and bads
- Chris discussed notes for fuel approval
 - o Give TMC the event and tag for approval

- o Check fuel gage to make sure it is empty
- Chris reminded road ranger 24/7 routes do not get OT code
- Chris advised all safe tow codes get turned into the office
- Chris reminded road rangers to be factual on the radio
- Chris advised road ranger do not accept any tips or compensation while working
- Chris went over the social media usage
 - o Do not post events on social media
 - o Do not post your employment as First Coast Road Ranger
- Chris told road rangers cell phone usage has gotten better
 - o Road rangers will be getting new phones within the next few weeks
- Chris went over who to go to for help
