- Phone Replacement Update
- MOT Training

- Chris started meeting by introducing new employees
- Chris went over topics that would be discussed throughout the meeting
- Chris went over reminders for road rangers of things to do before leaving the yard
 - Clean and wash the trucks inside and out
 - Check fluids and supplies
 - Check that all tools are present and secure
 - o Double check hygeine and uniform
- Chris discussed F.S. 316.011, use of emergency vehicles classifying road rangers as emergency vehicles
 - Do not use emergency vehicle use only turn around
- Chris went over general safety while driving
 - Drive in the right lane 5 mph below posted speed limit
 - Look 3 times before changing lanes and merging into traffic
 - Keep distance from the vehicle in front of you
- Chris reminded road rangers of things to do at an event
 - Stop safetly or turn around at next exit and come back to the event
 - Do not use official turn arounds
 - Pull off the roadway to read messages or edit an event
 - o Call TMC for all stops and sign boards up
 - Stay in communcation with TMC
 - Get all vehicle information
 - Deploy all 15 cones
- Chris went over the procedural errors for the month
- Chris discussed general safety for road rangers
 - Always wear your seatbelt as it is the law
 - o Do not follow motorist unless TMC request it
- Chris reminded road rangers it is officially hurricane season
 - Be prepared at home and have family prepared
 - Be prepared to work
 - Dee Dee discussed previous hurricane situations and how they would deploy road rangers. Even if it does not directly hit us, people will travel through our district
- Chris went over break and shift change notes

- o Limit to 15 minutes
- Do not take breaks between 6a-9am and 3pm-7pm
- Get off the yard by 6:15am
- Do not call off shift before the shift is over
- Chris went over flagged breaks and shift changes
- Chris discussed MOT notes
 - All 15 cones get placed out
 - Never place your back to traffic
 - o Always assume other drivers do not see you
 - Put a barrier between yourself and on coming vehicles
 - Never trust anyone but yourself
 - o Do not get in a hurry unless immediate risk to life or safety
- Chris showed MOT pictures good and bad from the month
- Chris went over general notes with road rangers
 - \circ $\,$ Be sure to check fuel gages before giving fuel and getting approval from TMC $\,$
 - 24/7 routes do not get overtime codes
 - Turn Safe Tow codes into the office
 - Be short and factual on the radio
 - o Do not accept any tips or compensation while working
 - Never take pictures of an event
 - Do not post on social media
- Chris advised new cell phones are successfully rolled out at Philips and Boote will be next week
 - Do not turn on hotspots
 - Do not use for personal use
- Chris went over chain of command and where to go for help
- Jackie discussed some notes from HR
- Chris asked if there have been any issues with any other vendors
- Chris concluded meeting
