- Chris started the meeting by welcoming everyone and introducing new employees
- Chris went over the topics to be covered this meeting
- Chris advised road rangers of things to do before leaving the yard
 - Clean and wash the trucks inside and out
 - o Check operations of fluids and supplies each shift
 - Check that all tools are present
 - Double check hygeine and uniform
- Chris went over F.S. 316.003 which classifies road rangers as emergency vehicles
- Chris went over things to do while driving
 - o Drive in the right lane 5 mph below posted speed limit
 - Look 3 times before changing lanes
 - Keep distance from vehicles in front of you
 - No texting while driving
- Chris discussed things to do while at an event
 - o Do not stop quickly to get to an event, use next exit to turn around and come back to it
 - Do not use official turn arounds
 - Pull off the road to read messages
 - o Follow chain of command at the event
 - o For all stops, call TMC
 - o Put sign boards up and deploy all 15 cones
 - o Do not use anything but issued cones for MOT. Do not use construction barrels for MOT
- Chris reminded road rangers you are on route for duration for your shift
 - o Do not come off of your route before your shift is over
 - Do not stage or park waiting for an event
- Chris went over the procedural errors for the month
 - o Will start doing retraining on Saturdays if you have multiple procedural errors
- Chris went over general safety notes

- Must wear your seatbelt
- Do not follow motorist unless requested by TMC
 - Amber Alert, Silver Alert etc
 - Do not break any laws to follow motorist
- Chris advised road rangers we are in hurricane season
 - o June 1st through November 30th
 - o Remember to have a plan in place and be prepared
 - Showed names of hurricanes. Have had 3 named storms already
- Chris went over breaks and shift changes
 - Breaks limit to 15 minutes
 - o Do not take breaks during peak traffic times unless it's an emergency
 - 6am-9am and 3pm-7pm
 - o Get off the yard by 6:15. Limit to 15 minutes on the yard
 - Discussed flagged breaks and shift changes
- Chris discussed MOT notes
 - All 15 cones get placed out
 - Sign boards up and call TMC
 - Maintain situational awareness
 - Never turn your back to traffic
 - Always assume other drivers won't see you
 - Put a barrier between yourself and on coming vehicles
 - Always assume someone will hit your truck
 - Do not sit in your truck on an event
 - Point your tires in a direction as if your vehicle will be pushed
 - Never truck anyone but yourself
 - Do not get in a hurry
- Chris went over MOT pictures

- Chris reminded road rangers of general notes
 - o Get approval from TMC before giving fuel
 - o 24/7 routes do not get overtime codes
 - o For all safe tows, turn code into the office
 - o Stay short and factual on the radio
 - o Do not take tips
 - o Do not post anything on social media
- Chris reminded road ranger do not use cell phones for personal use
 - o Do not send or receive personal text messages
 - Do not turn on hotspots
 - o Do not stream videos or music
- Chris discussed where to go for help
 - o Chain of command
- Chris went over HR notes
- Issues with any vendors?
- Chris concluded meeting
