1. FIRST COAST ROAD RANGERS PRESENTATION

Tactical Training

- Chris began meeting by introducing new employees
- Chris went over the topics to be covered in the safety meeting
- Chris reminded road rangers of things to do before leaving the yard
 - Clean the trucks inside and out
 - Check the operation of the truck and all fluids and supplies
 - Make sure all tools are in the truck
 - o Take inventory before you leave the yard
 - Double check hygeine and uniforms
- Chris went over F.S. 316.003 authorizing road rangers as emergency vehicles
- Chris discussed general safety of things to do while driving
 - o Drive in the right lane 5 mph below posted speed limit
 - Always look 3 times before merging into traffic
 - o Keep the proper distance from the vehicle in front of you
 - No usage of cell phones while driving
- Chris discussed general safety while on an event
 - Do not speed to respond to an event
 - o If you pass the event, go to next exit to turn around and come back
 - Do not use official turn arounds
 - Pull off the road to read messages
 - Follow chain of command at an event
 - All stops call in to TMC and put sign boards up
 - Stay in communication with TMC
 - o Get all vehicle information
 - Deploy all 24 cones
- Chris reminded road rangers they are on route for the duration of their shift
 - Do not stage
 - o Do not park

- Do not come off route early
- Chris discussed procedural errors
- Chris went over 2 general safety reminders
 - Always wear your seatbelt
 - o Do not follow motorists unless TMC request it
 - o When you are being over taken by another vehicle, slow down
 - Always watch for turn signals of vehicles passing you
- Chris advised we are towards the end of hurricane season
- Chris advised how to properly turn in the median if it is a must
- Chris reminded road rangers of break and shift change notes
 - Limit breaks to 15 minutes
 - Do not take a break during peak traffic times
 - 6am-9am and 3pm-7pm
 - o Get off the yard by 6:15am
 - Limit shift changes to 15 minutes
 - o Do not take your break near the end of your shift
- Chris went over flagged break times and shift changes
- Chris read a few job well done emails
- Chris discussed MOT notes
 - o All 24 cones get placed out
 - Maintain situational awareness at all times
 - Never turn your back to traffic
 - Put a barrier between yourself and oncoming traffic
 - Always assume someone will hit your truck
 - Never get in a hurry
- Chris showed some good and bad MOT pictures
- Chris reminded road rangers of a few general reminders

- Creat the event and give tag to TMC before giving fuel
- o 24/7 routes do not get overtime codes
- Turn all safe tow codes into the office
- o Be short and factual on the radio
- Do not accept any tips from motorists
- o Do not give motorists service suggestions
- o Never take pictures of events and post them on social media
- o Do not post FCRR as your employer and then post negative comments
- Chris remined road rangers company cell phones are for work use only
 - o Motorists can use company cell phones if they need to make a call
 - o Do not send or receive text
 - Do not stream videos or music
 - Do not turn on hotspot
- Chris advised road rangers where to go for help
- Chris discussed some HR notes
 - o Taking notes of flagged breaks and shift changes
 - Could be written up based on severity of procedural errors
 - o Policy updates are coming in January
- Chris reminded road rangers of some general notes
 - o Make sure trucks are clean
 - o Uniform shirts need to be buttoned and do not turn hat backwards
 - O Stay professional no matter the situation
 - Adkison tow yard is under construction
