- Chris welcomed everyone to the safety meeting
- Chris went over topics to be covered this meeting
 - General safety
 - Procedural errors
 - Breaks and shift changes
 - o MOT
 - o Radio etiquette and time on the radio
 - Cell phone usage
 - HR
- Chris reminded road rangers of things to do before leaving the yard
 - Clean trucks inside and out
 - Check operaiton of all fluids and tools
 - Make sure all tools are present and secured
 - Take inventory on the truck
 - Double check hygeine and uniform
- Chris discussed things to do while driving
 - o Drive in the right lane 5mph below posted speed limit
 - Look 3 times when merging into traffic
 - Keep proper distance from vehicle in front of you
 - No cell phone usage while driving
 - Always wear your seatbelt
 - Workers comp may not cover an accident if you are not wearing a seatbelt
 - Do not follow motorist unless requested by TMC
 - Do not make U-turns
 - When you are being passed by a vehicle, slow down and let them pass
- Chris went over things to do at an event
 - Drive and stop safetly

- Do not speed to an event
- If you pass an event, go to next exit to turn around
- Do not use official turn arounds
- Pull off the road to read messages
- Follow chain of command at an event
- All stops, call TMC and put sign board up
- Stay in communication with TMC throughout the event
- Get all vehicle information
- Deploy all 24 cones
- Chris went over F.S. 316.003 authorizing road rangers as emergency vehicles
- Chris went through the procedural errors for the month
- Chris reminded road rangers of break and shift change notes
 - No breaks during shift
 - If you need to use the bathroom, advise TMC and keep it shorter than 15 minutes
 - Do not use the restroom during peak traffic times unless it is an emergency
 - 6am-9am and 3pm-7pm
 - Get off the yard by 6:15
 - Limit shift changes to 15 minutes on the yard
- Chris went over flagged breaks and shift changes
- Chris discussed MOT notes
 - All 24 cones get placed out
 - Maintain situational awareness
 - Never turn your back to traffic
 - Always assume other drivers can not see you
 - Try to put a barrier between yourself and on coming traffic
 - Never trust anyone but yourself

- Unless it is an emergency, do not get in a hurry
- Chris showed MOT pictures
- Chris went over some general reminders
 - Create an event and get approval from TMC before giving fuel
 - 24/7 routes do not get over time codes
 - Turn all safe tow codes into the office
 - Be short and factual on the radio
 - \circ $\;$ Do not accept any form of tip or compensation from motorist
 - Do not recommend any services to motorist
 - Do not take pictures of an event
 - Do not post anything negative on social media
- Chris reminded road rangers company cell phones are for FCRR use and motorist use only
 - Do not stream, send text or turn on hotspot
- Chris went over where to go for help
- Chris asked if there have been any issues with other vendors
- Chris concluded meeting
